RESOLUTION NO. 14- 58**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING BALLOT LANGUAGE  
FOR THE PUBLIC TRANSIT SALES TAX ISSUE**

WHEREAS, the provisions of U.C.A. 59-12-2208 and 59-12-2214 provide that the governing body of a city may submit, by resolution, a proposal to its citizens to impose a sales and use tax of .25% to fund a public transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the \_\_\_\_\_ City Council have passed a resolution to submit the issue of an increased sales and use tax of .25% or \$0.25 per \$100 spent, to its citizens pursuant to U.C.A. 59-12-2214;

NOW, THEREFORE, the members of the \_\_\_\_\_ City Council, hereby adopt and pass the following ballot language to be submitted to its citizens in the general election to be held on November 6, 2014:

**Shall Logan City, Utah, be authorized to impose a .25% (one quarter of one percent or \$0.25 for every \$100 spent) sales and use tax for the dedicated purpose of funding a public transit system by the Cache Valley Transit District for the residents of Logan City?**
