MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TOQUERVILLE SECONDARY WATER SYSTEM WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH

Meeting date: February 13, 2024

1. Discussion and consideration for approval of 2024 watering times

The board discussion was optimizing the watering schedule for agriculture users. Ty Bringhurst mentioned that Lorin Lowe had been granted permission at the previous board meeting to have all his property on the same watering schedule, starting in March.

Dave Jessop raised a concern about low water pressure, specifically mentioning that Mike was the only one facing the issue from last year.

Joey Campbell proposed a change to the schedule, suggesting removing Old Church Rd to the north from the red zone and placing it in the orange zone.

After a thorough discussion the board financialized a new watering schedule. The red zone will now include Paul and Naegle, the green zone will have Mike, and the yellow zone will have Gilbert.

Joey Campbell made a motion to approve the 2024 watering schedule with the changes, the motion was seconded by Ty Bringhurst, and all voted aye.

2. Discussion of water pressure

This was discussed with the watering schedule.

Ty Bringhurst commented that for the next board meeting we need on the agenda to discuss if the bylaws allow new agriculture service if the area is within the service area, and discuss the new zone change with Toquerville City to have half acre agriculture lots.

Ty Bringhurst recommended a board meeting in May 2024 to evaluate the new watering schedule.

Dave Jessop made a comment that Toquerville City and Washington County Water District will meet to discuss the City taking over the TSWS system, then come back to TSWS board for discussion.

Anita Lowe asked if there is anything set up if homeowners are watering off schedule. Dave Jessop commented that there is no water policing, but if District staff or the public is in the area and notice a violator a letter will be sent. Mr. Jessop suggested to Anita if

she sees someone watering outside of their time, to take a picture and send it to Mindy so a letter can be sent out.


3. Consider approval of November 13, 2023, TSWS Board Minutes
