She presented a budget to the Foundation. Chair Silvestrini said the city would operate the Venture Out program and donations would come through the Foundation. The Foundation will have no employees, so labor costs will remain in the city's budget. Chair Silvestrini said the council would authorize city employees to work at festivals or other sponsored activities.
