Approval of Minutes: Chair Przybyla called for a motion to approve the minutes from the March 5, 2024 meeting. Ms. Redford moved to approve the March 5, 2024 minutes. Ms. Turner seconded the motion. 1. MAG Transportation Improvement Plan update ([click here for recording](#))

- Bob Allen is the contact with MAG (Mountainland Association of Governments)
- Center Street between Geneva and I-15, project is the one that was submitted for funding.
- Pursuing active transportation (pedestrian and biking) funding from federal, UDOT sources.
- 1600 North 400 East – Murdock Canal pedestrian bridge. Will pursue and receive grants.
- There are restrictions on where the grant money comes from and how it can be spent.
- Lakeview Parkway
 - Pooling money from 1600 North, 1150 South intersection extension, 1600 North 400 East

- Widening to five lanes, adding bike lanes, no building takes

- Responses on bike lanes against curb, cars are still being parked in bike lanes
- UDOT will put in 2nd left from 400 South to Geneva Road

- Rather have bike lanes on the outside of separating paint
- This is a highly visible crosswalk, mast arm
- Want it installed before next school year

- The City and Bike Orem are working toward a day in May that will be a Bike-to-Work day. Different businesses will donate breakfast, the mall is donating The Orchard outside space, stations for bike tune-ups and other things.
