**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:**

Mayor Scott O'Hare opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program and turned the time over to Tammie Morgan, project manager, to conduct the hearing. Tammie stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project awarded under the 2024 Community Development Block Grant Program. The town has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Deep Creek Bridge replacement project located on the west side of Snowville at approximately 500 W 25600 N. Tammie stated that she would be the project manager. Tammie explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and the Deep Creek Bridge replacement project was awarded \$292,000.00. Tammie explained the project to those in attendance. She explained that the funds would be used to pay for the match Snowville Town must come up with to complete the project through the UDOT funding. Tammie then asked for any comments, questions, and concerns from the audience. The only question that was asked was from Mike Morgan and he wanted to know what direction UDOT decided to go with the replacement of the bridge. Tammie informed him that they had a meeting with UDOT and they were going to try to go the cheapest route possible but that there would be other meetings in the future to discuss the exact process that would take place. Tammie stated that copies of the capital investment plan are available if anyone would like a copy. There were no more comments and the hearing was adjourned at 6:10 PM.
