UFRA: Raleigh is present. For the regional school on March 7th and 8th, would like to get some classes together that people want. Want to start getting all of those in the books, could do it for the next meeting too, just want everyone to start thinking about what they would like. Online testing for firefighter 1 and 2, hazmat ops, fire officer 1, fire investigator, and instructor 1, will start doing online testing for all of those now. Have a new program manager Jason Earl, who was an instructor prior to that. Russ Young is now assistant director will be over CTC, EADS, ARFF, and the fundamentals classes and any scheduling for those. Have a regional school in Huntington on April 26 and 27, will have forceful entry, vent box on Friday night the 26, the 27 doing pump operation simulator, plus forcible entry, and vent box. This will be on the UFRA website if anyone wants to register for that. Zack asks if we are going to go back to a more basic regional, we talked about doing a more basic regional this next year, because we did an advanced one this year. Elliot says it would be nice to have a hazmat class. Raleigh says they do a four hour fundamental hazmat, if that's what you're looking for. Elliot was wondering if we could tailor it for the more rural areas. Raleigh will look into all that, and get that for everyone at

the next meeting. Elliot says that with talking to law enforcement it would be good to have something to learn more about what certain chemicals together could mean. Would also like kind of what you do in fire 1 and 2, like live fire, flashover, can do both. What about an apparatus simulator? would be a nice prop, would like to have that. Raleigh will work on those classes.

Fire Warden: Jordon is present. As far as 130/190 basic red card class, only have names from Spring City, the best week for this for Jordon is April 29-May 4, is going to move ahead with those dates. Will be 6-10 on weekdays then full day Saturday. Shawn has a few, he will get Jordon those names. If everyone can get the inventory inspections on engines in google drive that would be great. Those who have FEPP equipment need the form signed by the chief and city council member. Rex asks if there is an engine boss coming up, no engine boss is in the works this year, do have Engine Academy on May 17 and 18 out near Delta. Haven't put together a registration place yet, hoping to get that soon.
