- Applications open: May 17, 2024
- Applications due: May 31, 2024, at 5:00 PM MST
- Applications presented to UHSB for approval in June 2024
- Contract Period: July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025

Summary:

- Per [Utah Code 35A-16-403](#), Tier 1 and Tier 2 eligible municipalities must submit an application for funding and present a request for account funds to the Utah Homeless Services Board (UHSB).
- The UHSB may consider the following factors in approving HSCM funding: a proposal outlining the need for eligible services; a description of the proposed use of account funds; a description of outcomes that the funding would be used to achieve; the strength of the proposal; if the entity received HSCM funding previously, the efficiency with which the entity used those funds; availability of alternative funding; and any other considerations identified by the board.
- The total available funds for FY25 are \$17,391,265
 - **Tier 1** \$15,217,356
 - **Tier 2** \$434,781
 - **Tier 3** \$1,739,126
- Per the funding formula outlined in Utah Code 35A-16-402, OHS has determined that the following cities are eligible for Tier 1 and Tier 2 HSCM funding in FY25.
