ATTENDING: Council Members Bo Harrison, Kent Nelson, Larry Packer, and Guy Webster; Employees; Tyler Hunt, Julie Spadafora

CONDUCTING: Mayor Pro Tempore Bo Harrison, the meeting began at 6:00 p.m.

ABSENT: Mayor Ren Hatt asked to be excused.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. Discuss/Approve/Deny Preliminary approval for extending the City's water system to the border of parcel 1-151-55
Parcel #1-151-55 was approved by Planning and Zoning. Bo Harrsion explained initially they were making them put in a fire hydrant on their property, but under the State Fire Marshall's direction the property line was sufficient. They will run an 8-inch line to the fire hydrant which must be done to the city's specification. Tyler Hunt said, eventually Carlos Quintana will want to build a house there. Kent Nelson commented, if they do decide to build another house, Tammy Howland would need to be involved again. Tyler stated, they will be paying for the line and then following the city's reimbursement policy. **MOTION:** Kent Nelson made a motion to approve extending the City's water system to the border of parcel 1-151-55. Ben Lehnhoff seconded the motion. **VOTE:** Bo Harrison, Kent Nelson, Larry Packer, and Guy Webster voted aye. The motion carried.

2. Discuss/Approve/Deny final approval and authorizing construction of the extension to the City's water system to the border of parcel 1-151-55
Tyler Hunt spoke, the city code requires a preliminary and a final based on an engineered plan. The contractor backed out on their engineered plans yesterday. Now that it is an 8 inch, it requires a fire hydrant. As long as the motion includes approval for construction, contingent upon the City's Engineer and Bryan Meadows signing off on the plans. **MOTION:** Guy Webster made a motion to give final approval and authorize the construction of the extension to the City's water system to the boarder of parcel 1-151-55 after the engineered plans have been signed off by the City's Water Superintendent and the City's Engineer and after the applicant has agreed in writing to the both obtain the needed easement and to accept the City's process of reimbursement. Larry Packard seconded the motion. **VOTE:** Bo Harrison, Kent Nelson, Larry Packer, and Guy Webster voted aye. The motion carried
