A. Minute Approval

B.1. Feb, March Minutes: Approved by Shan Lloyd, Jason McGuire seconded, none opposed.

C. New Business:

- C.1. Theater; Karyn Tucker at Arts Council-** Karyn from Sandbox came to thank the Arts Council for working with them and helping make the shows possible. She let all of Arts Council know that if they would like two comp theater tickets for this year, we will need the dates by April 22. We talked about some options that we could do for a fall show. Arts Council liked the idea of a comedy/murder mystery show in October or a Christmas kick off around Thanksgiving weekend. We did also talk about the possibility of some smaller weekend performances. We would just start out with one or two for the year and see if the community takes to them and if they are well attended.
- C.2. Art Show recap-** Art show is up and running and will be up at the Gale until April 26. We had a great turn out of entries and the reception was full despite it being over spring break. We did have a lot of the teen category winners not at the reception due to spring break. Overall, the show is going well. We did talk about the possibility of trying to move the show dates next year and to line up judging with the March Arts Council meeting. That way the show would fall well before spring break also; a few Arts Council members had a hard time coming to judge that week.
- C.3. Trax Update-** Janell and Tiffany had a meeting with Trax about the different options for the new DAYBREAK Trax station. The project should be in our budget and we are moving forward. Arts Council will be in charge of the call for art, and we will be covering the artist stipend, the wrap and installation costs. We will have follow up meetings/information with Trax about the process. We decided we are going to do the call for art differently and ask for portfolios rather than a full concept for submission.
- C.4. Spring Utility Boxes-** We have 3 spring boxes in our budget, we have already allocated budget to replace the artwork that was hit to another location and for the dog at the 2023 art show that was submitted too late for a fall install. Arts Council decided for the 3rd box to use Camille Grimshaw Arts Council choice award from the 2024 art show. These will be scheduled in early June. We like the areas on 11400, we need to replace the box on 40th west by Oquirrh Shadows and we mentioned looking for a location near Camille's for her artwork.

- C.5. Call for Art at Parks and Crosswalks-** Arts council went through all of the submissions for the artwork on the crosswalk and the urban park artwork. The artwork was approved with some modifications to one of the submissions. Tiffany will contact the artists for any requests on moving locations or modifying artwork. Jason McGuire approved, Shan Lloyd seconded and none opposed.
- C.6. Art on the Towne and Quilt Show-** The event date is Saturday May 11 from 10-3pm. We need a couple Arts Council members to help judge the Quilt Show at 9:30am that day. All Arts Council members should stop by and check out the event regardless if you are able to judge or not.
