RESOLUTION NO. 24-14**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2024 – 2028 CONSOLIDATED PLAN, FIVE YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN, AND A 2024 PROJECT YEAR ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May of 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to develop a Consolidated Plan (2024 – 2028) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program defining the City's community development and housing needs for the next five years; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to adopt a five year Strategic Plan as an element of its Consolidated Plan that identifies funding goals and priorities for the City's CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to develop an Annual Action Plan and submit for approval to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) delineating funding allocations to CDBG sub-recipients, strategic priorities and a community needs assessment for the project year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a five year Consolidated Plan, Strategic Plan, and an Annual Action Plan for Project Year 2024 delineating priorities that emphasizes the importance of funding projects that build lasting value in our community; and

WHEREAS, the City has met the requirements of the CDBG Citizen Participation Plan for public review and comment for the 2024 – 2028 Consolidated Plan, Strategic Plan, and PY2024 Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive approximately \$556,595 to allocate from HUD for PY2024; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the applicable requirements approved by HUD and outlined in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan requiring the formation of a steering committee to review and make recommendations on eligible applications for funding to the Logan City Municipal Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:

1. The 5 year Consolidation and Strategic Plans that identify community development housing goals along with funding priorities for the CDBG program for Program Years 2024 - 2028, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. The PY2024 Annual Action Plan, including funding decisions, the summary of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.

3. This resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.

 SUBJECT: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
 2024 Annual Action Plan/Funding Recommendations

The 2024 Annual Action Plan defines the funding priorities for project year 2024. This will be the first year of the 2024 – 2028 Consolidated Plan. HUD has released its funding allocations for 2024, and Logan will receive \$556,595 in CDBG funding.

Based on the Con Plan’s priorities, the funding outcome for 2024 should be approximately 60% to provide for a suitable living environment (50% to infrastructure & 10% to the remediation of access & mobility barriers), 20% to improve the capacity of public service providers that serve LMI residents (10% to public facilities improvements & 10% to public service activities), and 20% to CDBG administration and planning.

The CDBG Steering Committee met on April 9, 2024, and based on the applications received are recommending the following funding allocations:
