Commissioner Almquist and County Administrator Nicholle Felshaw were excused.


REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-3300, A RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN INTO ASH CREEK SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT


Mike Chandler, managing director of Ash Creek Special Service District related this process has been in discussion for a few years. The Town of Virgin has voted to annex into the Ash Creek Special Service District for immediate oversight of collection, treatment and disposal of sewage materials. The Washington County Commission will hold a public hearing on the proposed annexation on June 4, 2024 at 5:00 PM.

MOTION: Motion by Commissioner Snow to Adopt Resolution No. R-2024-3300, A Resolution Proposing the Annexation of the Town of Virgin Into Ash Creek Special Service District. Motion seconded by Commissioner Iverson and carried by unanimous vote, with Commissioners Iverson and Snow voting aye.
