



## Cottonwood Heights Notice of Public Hearing

### Proposed Executive Municipal Officers Compensation Increases

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, June 4, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as practical, at **2277 East Bengal Blvd., Cottonwood Heights, UT**. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive input on the City’s proposed compensation increases for its executive municipal officers. The schedule of proposed increases may be viewed or copied on the City’s website at [www.cottonwoodheights.utah.gov](http://www.cottonwoodheights.utah.gov) and at the office of the City Recorder at City Hall during normal business hours, for at least ten days prior to the hearing. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City will make reasonable accommodations to hearing participants that require such accommodations. Comments received **after 4:00 p.m.** local time on the hearing date will be forwarded to the city council but not entered into the meeting record or addressed during the meeting. A Zoom meeting link will be included in the posted agenda for the June 4, 2024, city council business meeting for those who wish to voice their comments via Zoom during the public hearing.
