EARLY VOTE will be in the Clerk-Auditor's Office during normal business hours, M-F, 8 am to 5 pm, Tuesday, June 11 - Friday, June 21.
Closed June 17th to observe Juneteenth.

There is only one **VOTE CENTER** open on Election Day, **Tuesday, June 25th** in the Commission Chambers of the County Building at 147 E Main; **Open from 7 am to 8 pm.**

You must bring in your ID and proof of residency, if you have moved.

There are several **DROP BOX** locations throughout the County: Ballard City Offices, Naples City Offices, Vernal City Offices, and the County Bldg.

All open during normal business hours; and the Library drive-thru open 24/7.
All are under video surveillance.

The Election will be **AUDITED** for accuracy, Wednesday, July 3rd at 10 am.

Feel free to stop by the Uintah County Clerk-Auditor's office at 147 East Main.

The **CANVASS of Election** will be held Tuesday, July 9th at 3 pm in the Commission Chambers in conjunction with the Commission meeting.
