4. Quarterly Facilities Update

Lane Rose, Facilities Director, updated the Board on current projects. He said the Centerville HVAC project is 99% complete and will be finished very shortly, the Layton cleanup along the creek has begun with tree and stump removal, the Headquarters facade replacement is moving along with the selection of materials, and the Kaysville branch carpet has been selected and will most likely be installed in June.

Lane told the Board that after multiple meetings with Bountiful City, the Library is moving forward with an RFP for an architect. The Library wants to make sure the land fits the Library's building needs before the land swap is completed. There is talk of sharing a campus with the Health Department if there is room on the lot. Commissioner Kamalu and Josh stressed that the priority is making sure the Library has the land and the room it needs.

The Board thanked Lane for providing the update.

5. 2024 Summer Reading Program

Kim Valeika shared the Summer Reading program with the Board. There will be children's, young adult, and adult reading trackers and prizes again this year. There are many exciting programs including multi-cultural dance companies, small animal visits, Hill Air Force Base Museum, the Clark Planetarium, and magic shows. For the first time the Library will be participating in the Library Speaker's Consortium Summer Reading program which will include streaming some children and young adult author programs in the libraries.

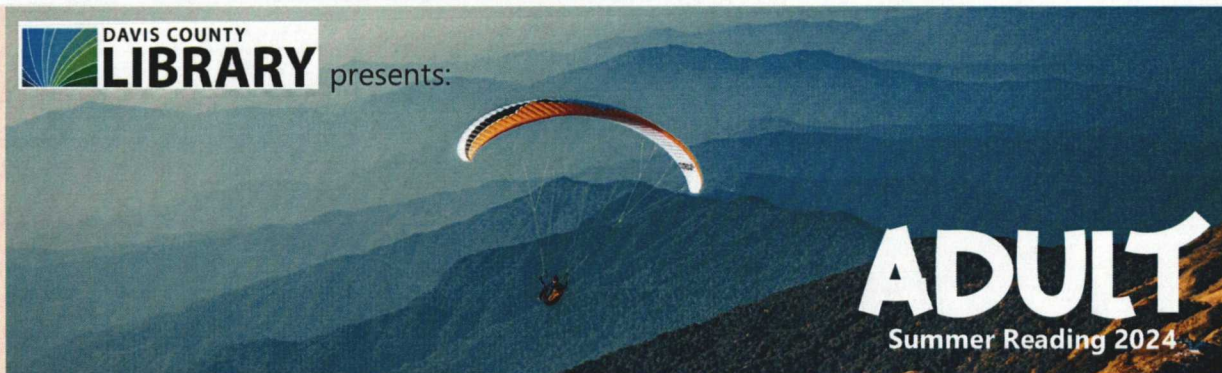
