Project: Ventana Subdivision Plat

Location: The Ventana Subdivision Plat is located within the approved

Mayflower Master Development Plan (MDP), west of U.S. Highway 40 near exit 8, at the south west point of the Jordanelle Reservoir,

south of the Deer Valley East Village core.

Applicant: BLX Ventana LLC

Representative: Erik Anderson

Recommendation: Staff recommends the MIDA Board approve the Ventana

Subdivision Plat, as recommended by the MRF DRC, subject to the completion of the Conditions of Approval as presented in this staff

report.

Background:

Per Chapter 2, Sections 2.02(A) and 2.02(F) of the Development Standards and Guidelines, MIDA requires Subdivision Plat approval before construction on any property within the MIDA Control Area. To meet this requirement for the construction of the Marcella Landing Subdivision, the Applicant (BLX Ventana) has submitted a draft Ventana Subdivision Plat for review and approval. Staff has reviewed the submitted plat and associated information and has provided comments to the Applicant. The Applicant has since resubmitted updated information for approval and in preparation for this DRC meeting.

Project Description:

The Ventana Subdivision Plat proposes subdividing Lot 2 of the Deer Springs at Jordanelle Plat into four parcels (Parcels 1-4). The parcels include a Rocky Mountain Power substation, a JSSD water tank, and a pumphouse, with an additional parcel designated for utility access. This plat is solely for utility providers and does not involve any other development.

Analysis:

Generally, the plat submittal includes everything that is required in the Development Standards and Guidelines. Specific items of consideration include:

 Parcels 1-3 are surrounded by Parcel 4 without any specific accesses defined.
 The proposed plat proposes blanket access easements for Rocky Mountain Power, JSSD, and BLX Water LLC.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends the MIDA DRC recommend to the MIDA Board approval of the Ventana Subdivision Plat based on the following conditions of approval:

1. Access easements for Rocky Mountain Power, JSSD, and BLX Water LLC are granted and recorded concurrently with the Ventana Subdivision Plat.
