T-Ball/ Boys Coach Pitch

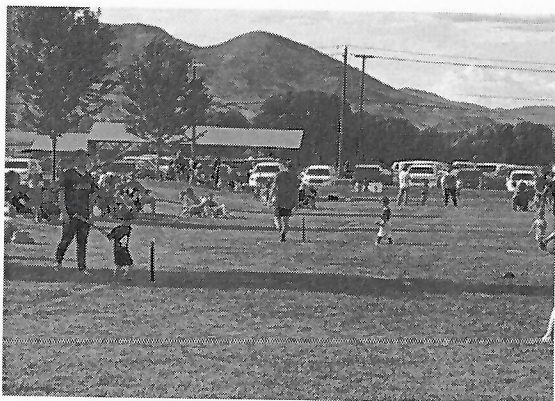
T-Ball 211 Participants

This Program is a month long and the kids play games twice a week. Every game is an hour long and the kids all get to bat around 3 times, as well as play in the field. We give each coach a bat and a tee as well as a dozen soft baseballs for t-ball. The coaches will bring these to every game so there kids can play. I have a great group of coaches this year and the kids seem to be having a ton of fun.

For Coach Pitch the coaches get an equipment bag with helmets bats and baseballs. This is a step up from t-ball where the coaches actually pitch to their players. Each team bats around 3 times and play in the field as well. At this age the kids use real baseballs and play more of an actual position in the field.

We find all the coaches and put together the schedules and coaching packets for both programs. We also go down and mark our fields we need for the season. As the games are going I go around to each field and make sure the games are started and answer any questions throughout the night. 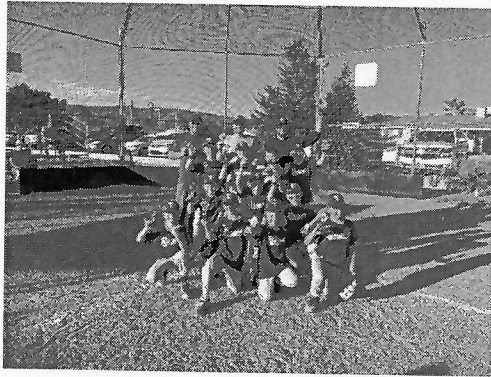

Boys Baseball

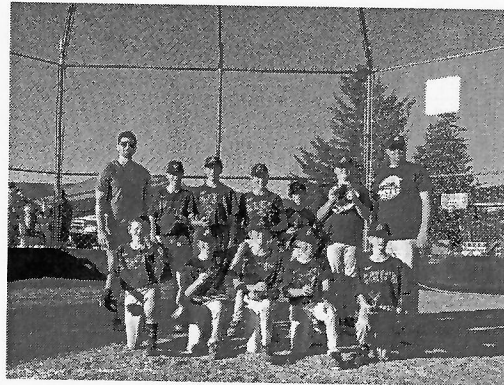
