Kevin Johnson asked why they are not getting sprayed in the Myton? Director Weight responded by saying we had a request from Kim Bellon in February that her property NOT be sprayed for mosquitoes. She stated she had a medical condition and didn't want the spray on her vegetable garden. He also stated there is one other gentleman in Myton that has a respiratory illness and they do not fog at his home either. The chemicals used are environmentally friendly. A mineral oil base is used on water, it coats and kills the larvae.

Director Weight continued by saying Myton sits on a swamp with a lot of Tribal land. He suggested the residents also contact the Tribal Mosquito Director Rick Chapoose.

Director Weight went on to say that the Myton area is and has been sprayed / fogged. The newer foggers are very quiet and the chemicals he is currently using do not have an odor / smell. He cannot control the drift, but tries to spray when the wind is from the West and less than 10 miles an hour.

Chipper commented that the fogging only takes care of the adult mosquitoes. Samantha Young said we all irrigate, can we treat our own irrigation water?

*(Annette McRae entered the meeting at 7:42 p.m.)*

Director Weight went on to say putting a small amount of vegetable oil in standing water will take of the larvae. It only lasts about 30 minutes, but the key is getting the larvae before they hatch.

Myton Daze are coming up, Director Weight said he will fog a couple times before it starts.

Director Weight stated he received two complaints from the Tabiona area. Because there was an outside wedding and quite a few people camping, he went ahead and treated the area. However the traps they had set

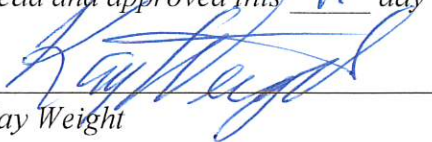
caught not one mosquito.

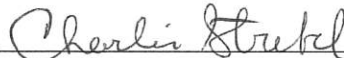
