**INVITATION TO BID

Sealed BIDS for construction of the "STORM DRAIN, PARK-N-RIDE LOT & ACCESS TRAIL PROJECTS ALONG FORT UNION BOULEVARD AND BIG COTTONWOOD CANYON ROAD, WEST AND EAST OF WASATCH BOULEVARD --- PROJECT # CHC.279-275", will be received by the City of Cottonwood Heights at the City Offices, 1265 East Fort Union Boulevard, Suite 250, Cottonwood Heights, Utah, until 2:00 PM, AUGUST 26, 2014; and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The work includes furnishing all labor, tools, materials, equipment, transportation and services required for the construction of the above described projects, located in the City of Cottonwood Heights; consisting of the following items of work: mobilization and traffic control; erosion control; clearing and grubbing work areas; constructing storm drain systems, including pipe and fittings, miscellaneous structures, storm water treatment system, restoring improved areas, restoring native vegetation, and all appurtenant work; constructing park-n-ride lot, including: removing existing asphalt pavements; roadway and general earthwork; borrow for backfill and fill; relocating existing water lines and gas lines; constructing 30" and 24" concrete curb and gutter, 6-foot wide sidewalks, walkways, concrete medians, ADA accessible ramps, and stamped concrete cross-walks; constructing paved areas, including granular borrow for sub-base, untreated road base material, asphalt surface course for roadways and parking areas, paint for traffic striping and messages, traffic signs, and all appurtenant work; constructing area lighting systems, including conduits, junction boxes, electrical conductors, light poles and fixtures, concrete footings, connecting to existing power systems with meter pedestals, and all appurtenant work; constructing access trail to existing parking lot, including: general earthwork, disposing of excess excavated material; final trail grading, constructing embankments and fills, compacting, and base preparation; constructing asphalt trails, including gravel road base and asphalt surfaces, and gravel shoulders along trails; connecting new trail to existing trail, including modification of existing handrail; constructing concrete block retaining walls; furnishing and installing fabricated metal handrails, including removable section; furnishing and installing bollards at trail entrance; constructing new concrete curb and gutter and trail entrance; constructing new asphalt pavement at existing parking lot; furnishing and applying paint for trail striping and parking lot re-striping; furnishing and installing regulatory signs; restoring native vegetation, including erosion control mat; removing and disposing of existing storm drain manhole and furnishing and installing storm water treatment system; furnishing and applying slurry seal for portion of existing parking lot; and all appurtenant work to complete project; all in accordance with Drawings and Specifications prepared by the Engineer, Gilson Engineering.

The Engineer's Opinion of Cost for Total Project, with Schedules "A", "B" & "C-1", is between \$1,105,500 and \$1,351,000; and for Total Project, with Schedules "A", "B" & "C-2", is between \$986,000 and \$1,205,500

CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be examined at the City Offices, 1265 East Fort Union Boulevard, Suite 250, Cottonwood Heights; and at the office of Gilson Engineering, 12401 South 450 East, Bldg. C-2, Draper, Utah.

Copies of CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be obtained from the office of Gilson Engineering for non-refundable payment of \$40.00 for each set, made payable to Gilson Engineering.

Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified Check or Cashier's Check in the amount of 5% of the maximum bid price, drawn payable to the order of the City of Cottonwood Heights.

All Bids submitted shall be in conformance with the Instructions to Bidders which are included in the Contract Documents; and shall be guaranteed by the Bidder for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of Bid opening.

The City of Cottonwood Heights hereby reserves the right to reject any or all bids presented, to waive any informality in a bid, and to make award or refuse to make award in the interest of the City.
