AMERICA250 CELEBRATION MINUTES

REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Welcome:

Commissioner Iverson welcomed all in attendance and begin the meeting at 11:01 am. He thanked everyone for accepting a role in the planning committee. Commissioner Iverson gave a brief back ground on why the board was created.

Website Status:

Washington County Webmaster Gavin Joaquin gave an update on the web domains that Washington County has purchased with both .com and .org extensions. He highlighted the difficulty of purchasing .gov domain names. The domains purchased are: America250Event, America250Strong, HonorAmerica250, America250Info, America250WashingtonCountyUtah, and America250Utah with both .com and .org extensions.

Youth Council:

Wendi Bulkley stated the Washington City Youth Council will start meeting in August again, and starting next month a representative for Youth Council will be attending meetings. The Youth Council will also coordinate with other cities Youth Councils.

School Events:

Nate Esplin, Assistant Superintendent over Elementary Schools for Washington County School District stated he can help coordinate events in schools. The St. George Chamber of Commerce and United We Pledge will work together to coordinate a Civics Bee, and will follow up with Mr. Esplin.

Logo Contest:
