

**WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMISSION  
MEETING MINUTES  
JULY 9, 2024**

The Special Meeting of the Board of the Washington County Commission was called to order by Chairman Gil Almquist at 4:00 p.m. on July 9, 2024, in the Washington County Commission Chambers, and via Zoom 111 East Tabernacle, St. George, Utah. Those in attendance were Commissioner Gil Almquist, Commissioner Victor Iverson, Commissioner Adam Snow, Deputy County Attorney Devin Snow, County Administrator Nicholle Felshaw and Deputy Clerk Sarah Lloyd.

**BOARD OF CANVASSERS MEETING:**

Washington County Clerk/Auditor Ryan Sullivan read aloud the results from the June 25, 2024 Regular Primary Election. He reported that there are 69,026 registered Republican voters, and there were 36,648 ballots that were cast for a voter turn out of 53.09%. 2,413 ballots were not counted, which included 662 that were returned past deadline, 1370 were undeliverable, 342 uncured, 13 uncountable, and 26 provisional ballots that were not counted.

Mr. Sullivan commented on the issues with the United States Post Office, and requested that voters use County drop boxes when available, or mailing ballots early to ensure they are postmarked before Election Day.

Commissioner Almquist thanked the Clerk/Auditor staff and all volunteers for this election. He further stated he met with the postmaster in St. George Utah, and spoke regarding improving the election process when it comes to vote by mail. Commissioner Iverson discussed promoting the ballot drop boxes with future elections.

Mr. Sullivan thanked his staff and other County employees for all the help and hard work regarding the election.

Commissioner Snow stated that the Commissioners would like a public statement regarding the June 25 primary.


