1. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, Prayer
Jim Lemmon called to order 9:00 am

2. Review Minutes from February 20 and April 16, 2024

Kate Wadsworth clarified that Brett made motion on item 3 during the 4/16/24 meeting. Kate Wadsworth motioned for approval of minutes, Cathy Clark Seconded, Unanimous approval.

3. Consideration and possible recommendation to the City Council regarding the assignment of the Richard L. Frost lease to Ray Schureman for a hangar pad located at 5 South at the Hurricane Airport.

Dayton Hall wanted to clarify the location. Lease says 5 S, asked if it is 5 S 1E. Steve Lemmon clarified its location is just assigned as 5 S.

Derek Hall motions to recommend approval to City Council for assignment of the lease. Scott Freeman seconds. Unanimous approval.

4. Sand Hollow Aviation Association report-Steve Lemmon

Steve Lemmon provided update on airport days, and that it went well. Had about 300 visitors over the day, mostly families. Learned how to structure it a bit better for the future. The picnic tables are still out there, Mike Vercimak will let them know to come get them.

Mr. Lemmon handed out a government declaration on the Utah aviation industry and how it benefits the state. Aviation conference happening in Layton. Some locations have put plastic and rocks down to mitigate weeds.

Mayor will show declaration to Council.

Scott Freeman says with flight school, his number of students has quadrupled. He spoke on training. Hurricane could have an opportunity for better flight school. Saint George will start their tower in a year and this will help with training as well since they do not have to travel so far for tower landing training. Mr. Lemmon states tower will help people land at better times, so they do not have to continue on to Nevada in the dark. He also gave an update on his hanger construction. He made sure his hanger would handle most of the plane that would land in Hurricane without making it extremely tall, only 16'.

Discussion ended.

5. New Business

Mike Vercimak- maintenance. The mower on tractor is temporarily down. Sprayer is ordered for it for weeds. Purchased a used broom for the runway.

Scott Freeman asked if anyone has heard any noise complaints. No one has.

Kurt McDaniel spoke on the crack seal project, just need seal and temporary paint.
