Don Tingey read public comment submitted through email from South Jordan resident Dan Langford.

My name is Dan Langford, a South Jordan resident and leader of the Daybreak Disc Golf Club. Disc golf courses in Utah typically see increased engagement in May as school ends, the weather warms, and days get longer. However, our course experienced a 29% decrease in usage from April to May, primarily due to overgrowth and lack of maintenance. In response, the Daybreak Disc Golf Club volunteered 34 hours over multiple days to keep the course playable. We mowed fairways with our own equipment, cleaned up litter, and moved debris to facilitate future mowing. While we are committed to supporting the park during its establishment, this level of volunteer maintenance is not sustainable long-term. We hope the local crew can periodically run a mower down the fairways to maintain the course. Additionally, three of the four new baskets have been delivered and installed, making the course more accessible to new players, families, and casual disc golfers.
