Dear Davis County Commission,

The Davis County Board of Health is writing to express our support for the pilot program temporary variance request submitted by Utah Mobile Emissions to the current Davis County Vehicle Emissions Inspection/Maintenance Program Ordinance – Section 10.12.070(A)(2). The request is pertaining to the requirement for a permanent location for a testing station. Utah Mobile Emissions has demonstrated the capability to conduct emissions inspections that meet all other requirements of the I/M program, ensuring compliance with both county and state regulations.

The primary objective of the Davis County Emissions Inspection/Maintenance Program is to improve air quality, reduce visible air pollution, and comply with federal and state laws. After careful deliberation and consultation with the health department staff, the Board of Health has concluded that this pilot program variance request aligns with the program's goals. We believe that allowing mobile emissions testing will not negatively impact the air quality of Davis County nor compromise the integrity of the I/M program.

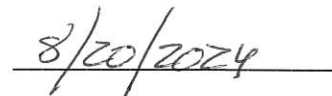
