Davis County Board of Health Regulation

Proposed Changes to the Food Service Sanitation Regulation

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 26A-1-121(1), the Davis County Board of Health held a public hearing on June 27, 2024, to receive public comments concerning proposed changes to the existing **Food Service Sanitation Regulation**.

The current **Food Service Sanitation Regulation** adopts Utah Administrative Code R392-100 Food Service Sanitation, dictates permitting information, and sets fees pertaining to the regulation of food service establishments. The proposed changes to the regulation include:

- Updating the name of Utah Administrative Code R392-102 from Food Truck Sanitation to Mobile Food Business Sanitation.
- Removing the Limited-Use Food Establishment permit and associated requirements.
 - This was primarily used to permit food carts. They are now included as Mobile Food Businesses.
- Specifying requirements for commissaries.
- Adding language to specify that a food establishment permit is required if you advertise offering food for public consumption.
- Revising the renewal language to require payment 30 days prior to operating each year rather than 30 days prior to expiration so that this regulation also applies to food operations that only operate seasonally.

Copies of the proposed changes to the regulation were made available to the public on the Department's website and the Environmental Health Division office located at 22 South State, Clearfield, Utah. Notice of this meeting has been publicly posted on the Davis County Health Department Website, Utah Public Notice Website, Davis County Administration building, and the Davis County Health Department building, on June 13, 2024 through June 27, 2024 , both papers of general circulation. Notice was also given on the Department's website and the State of Utah's public notice website.

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Hearing Summary:

The public hearing was held at 5:00 p.m. on June 27, 2024, in room #2021 of the Davis County Health Department, Clearfield, Utah. Written comments were received by the Department at the Environmental Health Division until 5:00 p.m. July 5, 2024.

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No public comments were received at the hearing or in writing.
