## Review of Changes

- Updating the name of Utah Administrative Code, Chapter R392-102, from Food Truck Sanitation to Mobile Food Business Sanitation.
- Eliminating the Limited-Use Food Establishment permit.
  - This was primarily used for food carts, now permitted as a Mobile Food Business
- Specifying requirements for commissaries.

## Review of Changes

- Adding language to specify that a food establishment permit is required if you advertise offering food for public consumption.
- Revising renewal language so that it applied to all food permits.
- Updating the fee schedule.
  - New fees: HACCP Plan Review, Residential Care Inspection

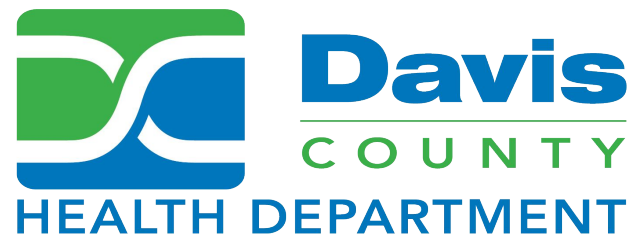

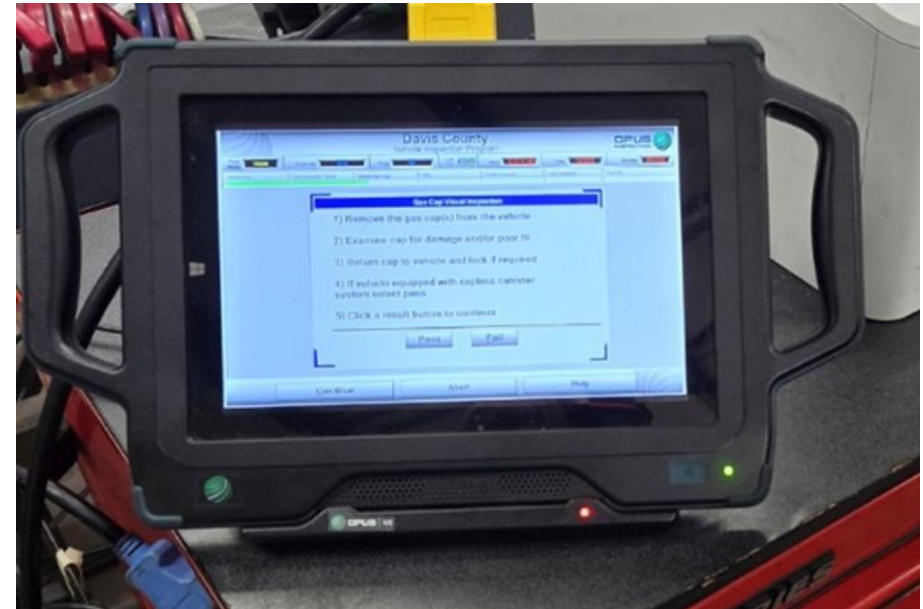


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# New Testing Equipment

# Request to Allow for Mobile Emissions

- All inspections must be conducted in view of a designated lane camera.
- Pictures must be taken of emissions components and tampering.
- All inspections must be immediately uploaded by the State to enable motorist ability to register vehicle.
- The Department needs to be able to conduct station, inspector, and covert audits.
- The Department needs to be able to verify all inspections are completed within Davis County.
- One free re-inspection is required if a vehicle fails an emissions inspection.
- Permits are only valid for the person and location to which it is issued.

## 1. Bay Camera

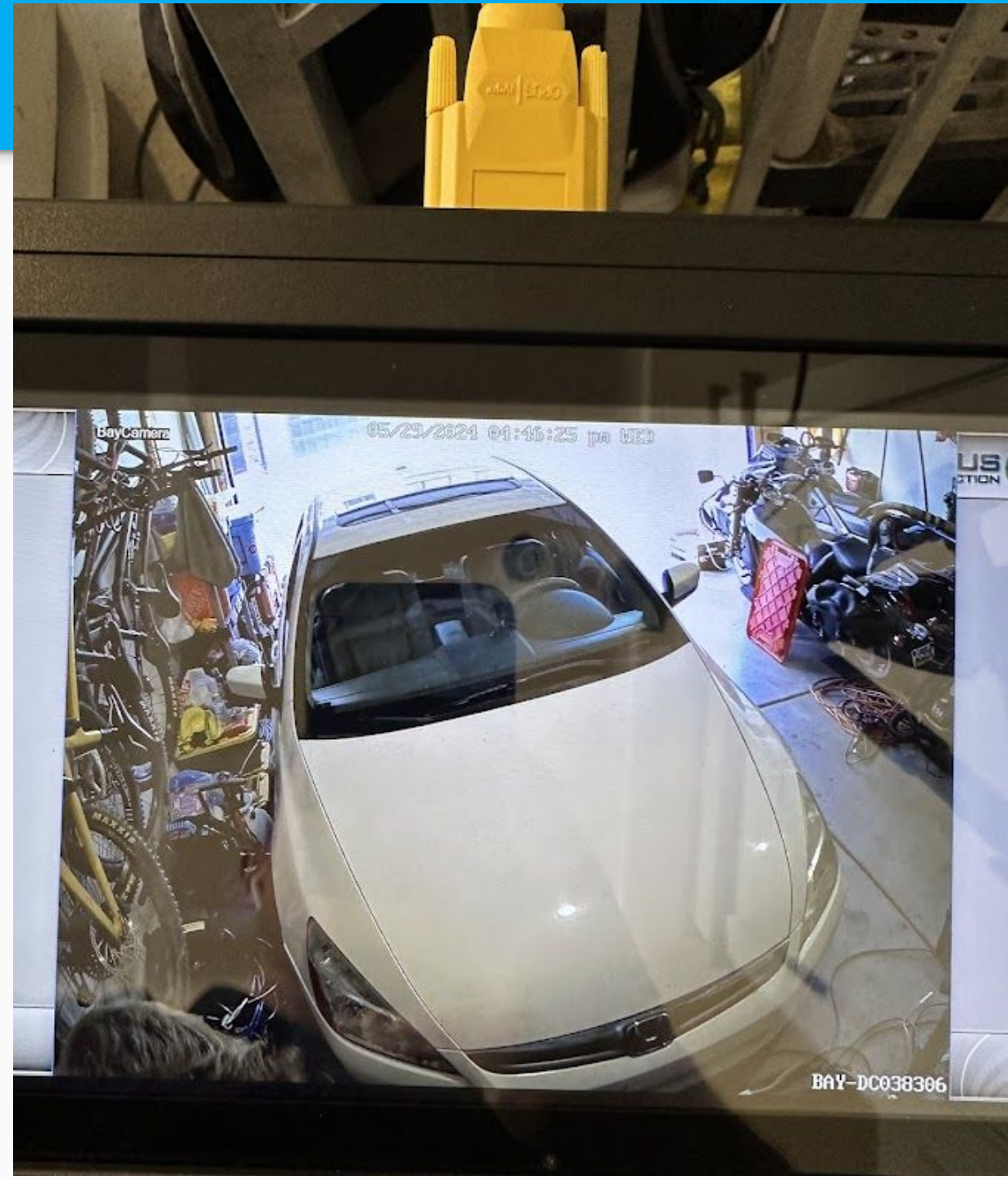
- Place in front or on side of the vehicle

## 2. Check View of Bay Camera

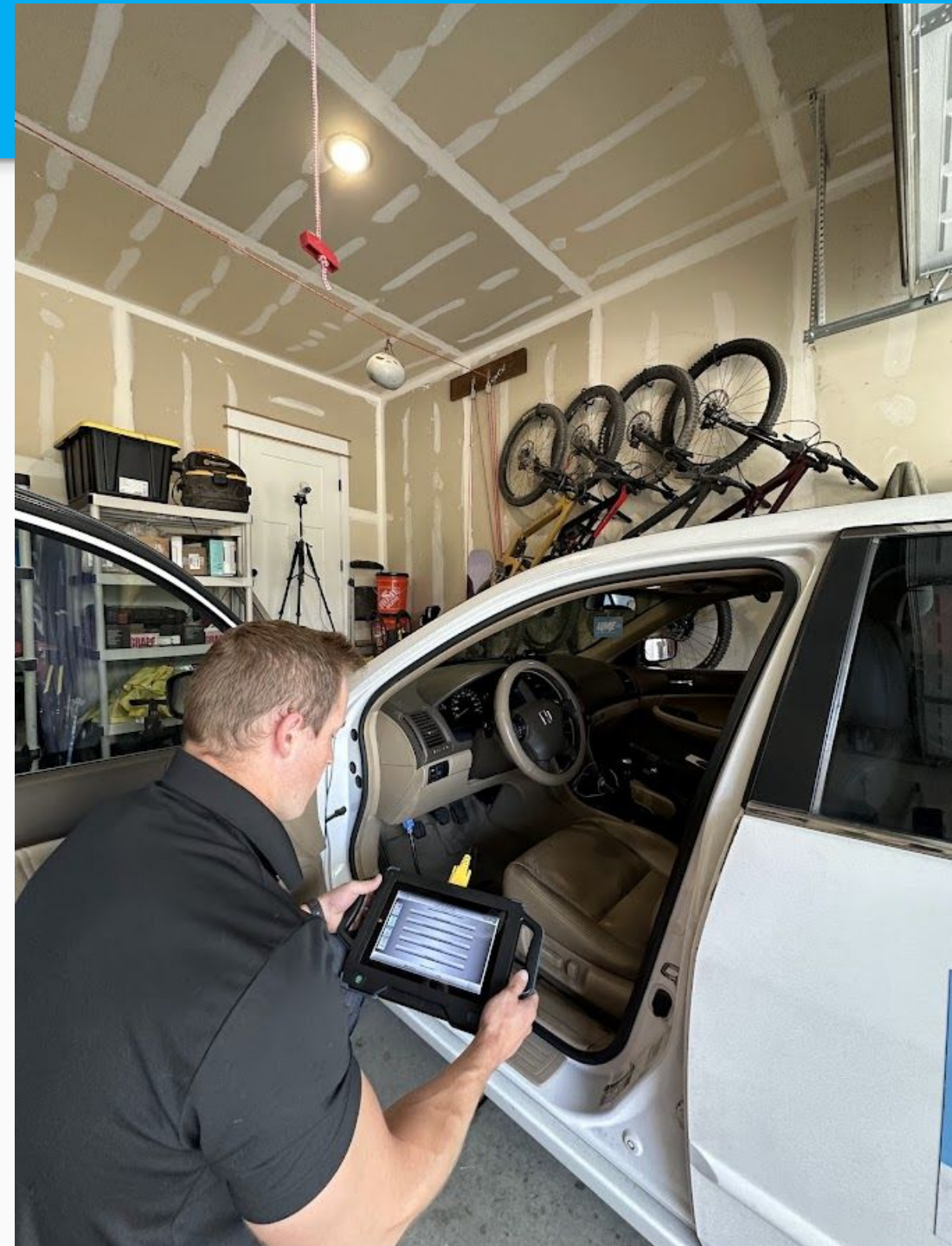
- Ensure that entire vehicle can be viewed

## 3. Proceed with OBDII Test

- Taking pictures of License Plate, VIN and VECI Label



## 4. Visual Inspection

- Using VECI label and approved emissions guides
- Verify all emission components for vehicle are present



## 4. Visual Inspection

- For smaller vehicles we use a borescope to take pictures of components under the vehicle



## 4. Visual Inspection

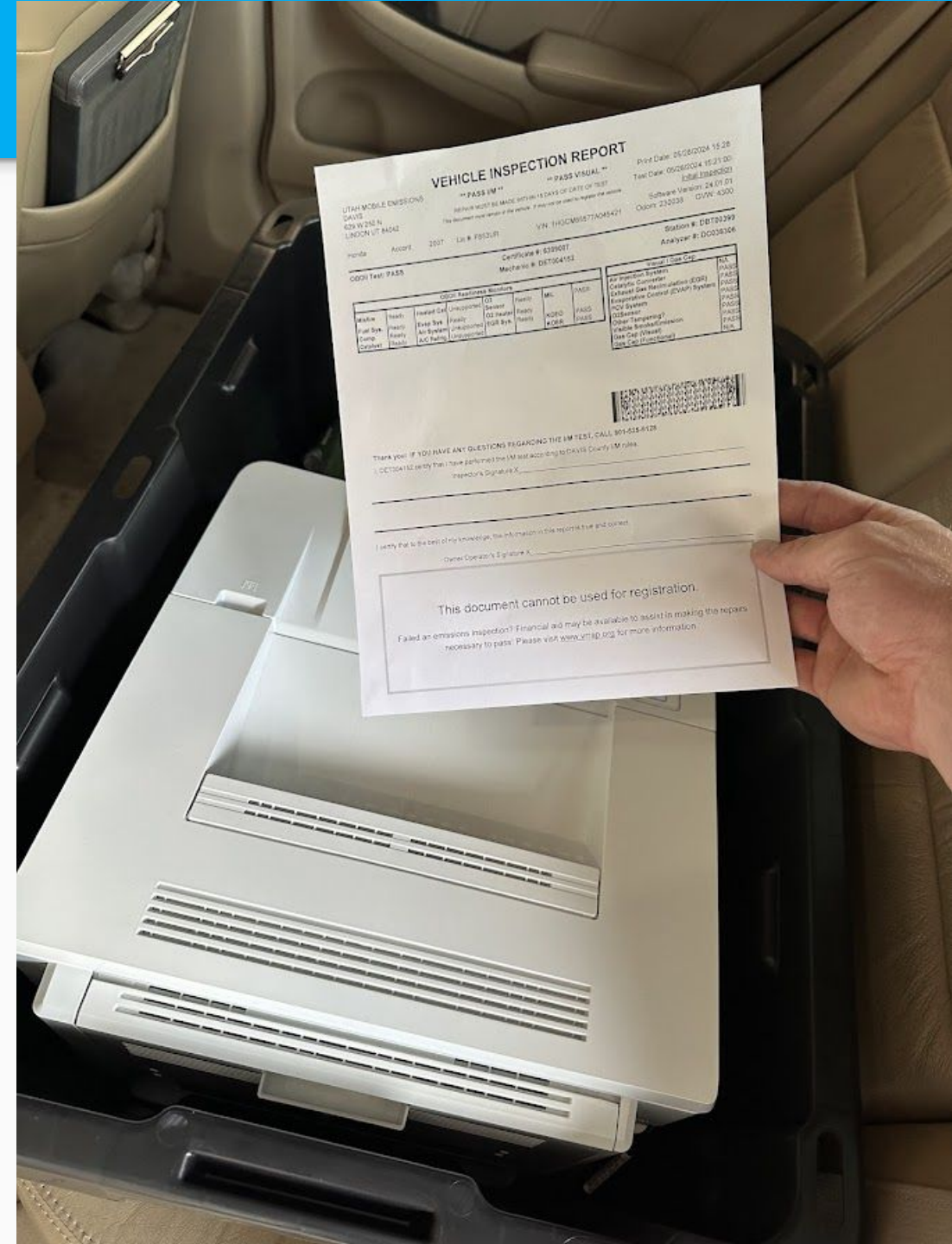
- Capturing up close HD photos of O2 Sensors and Catalytic Converter

- Finalized report is printed off and given to the customer

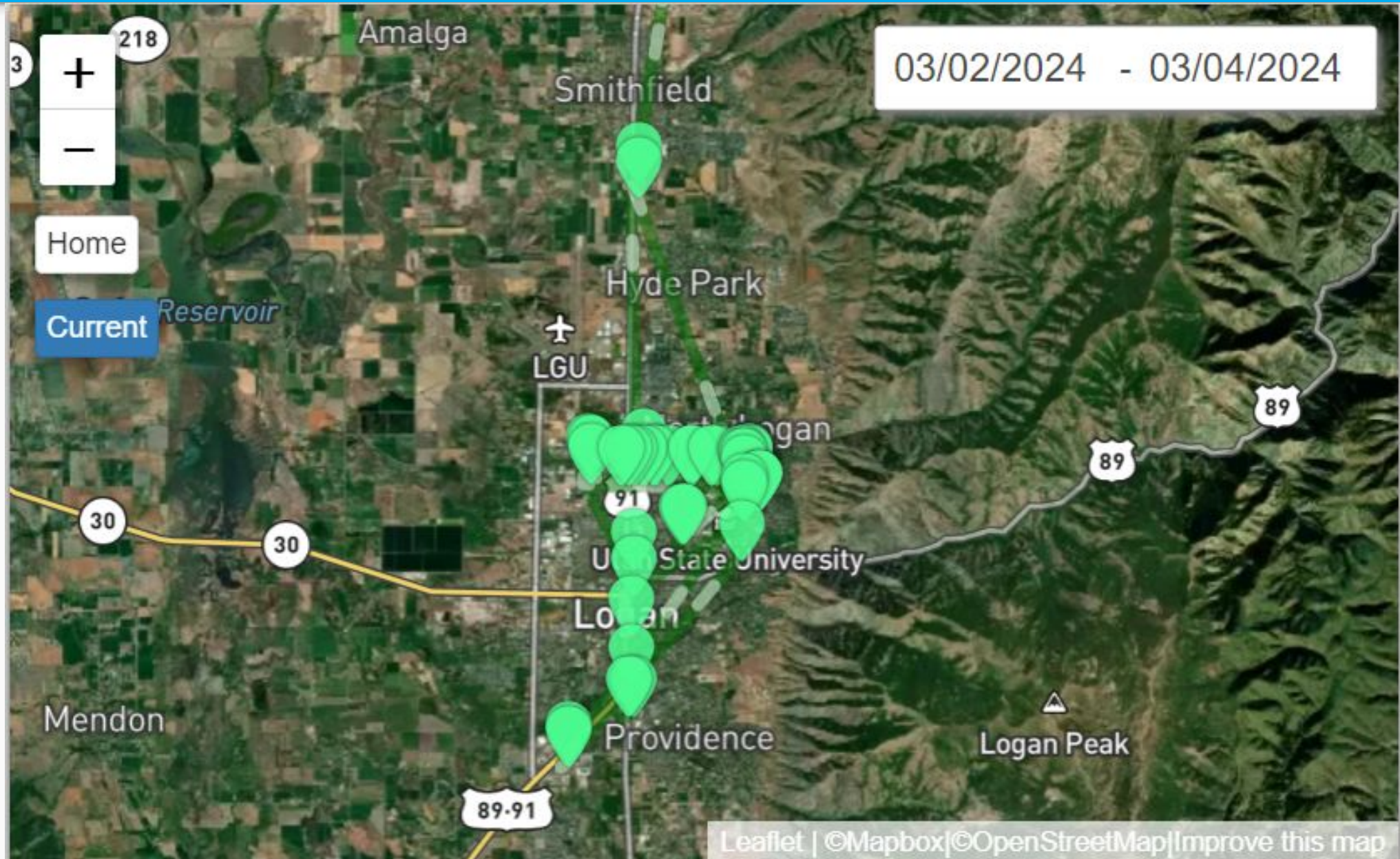


# Geofencing

# Board Action Requested

- Letter of Support to the Davis County Commission for approval of a Pilot Program for Mobile Emissions Testing.
  - This would include a temporary variance to allow for a permit to be issued to a person who complies with all other requirements to test at various locations throughout Davis County.
  - ***Davis County Vehicle Emissions Inspection/Maintenance Program - Section 10.12.070(A)(2)***  
“A permit is non-transferable and is valid only for the person and location to which it is issued.”
