

CANVASS OF 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION RECOUNT
August 2, 2024

Minutes of the Canvass of Election meeting of the Sevier County Commissioners held this second day of August 2024. Meeting commenced at 9:30 a.m. with Commissioners Scott Johnson, Greg Jensen, and Ralph Brown in the Commission Chambers of the Sevier County Administration Building, 250 North Main, Richfield, Utah. Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall and Deputy Clerk/Auditor Barbara Crowther were also present.

Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall noted that a request had been received by the Utah Lt. Governor's Office from Mr. Colby Jenkins requesting a recount of the Second Congressional Race as allowed by Utah Code. He listed the activities that had been involved in that process. Barbara Crowther reviewed the number of ballots that had been counted during the Primary Election, as well as the number of ballots not eligible to be counted due to late postmark or non-matching signature. She reviewed the schedule of activities for the recount required by the Utah Code, noting that the required audit for a recount is 3% of the ballots processed. The Commission reviewed the results of the election recount, and thanked the Clerk/Auditor Office for the work they had done to ensure that proper procedures had been followed. After discussion, Commissioner Brown moved to declare the recount results as official, and approve the 2024 Primary Election Recount Canvass, second Commissioner Jensen, unanimous.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.
