Another successful Fair with a twist here and there. The weather was great for us this year it was great to use the water truck instead of worrying about the rain. The Livestock show and sale were as good as usual. Our community did it again, they came out in droves to support the FFA and 4H programs at the sale, exhibits, the Derby and Rodeo.

Mountain Valley Stampede

We made a few changes this year. The first and best decision I think we made is increasing the prize money. In doing so we changed the map of how the contestants enter the rodeos that are around us. they made the decision to not miss our rodeo. We had more of the top 10 contestants at our rodeo that we have ever had before. We also had contestants that have never been here before and have told us they wouldn't miss it again. The department hired Jennifer Boman to take care of the sponsor program she is great and has brought a lot of help. We changed some of the sponsor programs to be more inviting and give our sponsors more bang for their dollar, increasing our sponsor participation.
