1. Welcome and Roll Call

Annie Bommer welcomed every and asked for a roll call. Everybody introduced themselves.

2. Approval of previous meeting minutes.

2.a Approval of the May 15, 2024 Minutes

Annie asked if there were any changes to the minutes and nobody had any changes. David Hales made a motion to approve. Christa Hutchinson seconded the motion. It was approved on a 6-0 vote.

3. Agenda Items

Jennifer Jastremsky mentioned that David has asked for his items to be moved up on the agenda as he has to leave the meeting early. Angie Quinlan made a motion to move items 3j, 3k, and 3m up on the agenda. The motion was seconded by Christa and passed with a 6-0 vote.

3j. Native American History

David mentioned that Jason Wiggins and Wendy Atzet were going to wordsmith what they had been working on. He suggested a plaque in Pioneer Park to state that there were Native Americans in the area. Annie had an update that Wendy, Jason, and she have gathered resources on the topic to further dive into.

3k. Draper Ethnic and Minority Research

David hasn't heard anything from anyone he has contacted. Mike Akagi will be back from his mission in July and he does want us to get their photograph albums digitized. Corina Pace suggested inviting the people David has contacted to a dinner to get them to come and share information. David stated the ethnic groups he has been looking into are Italians, Greeks, Mexicans, Japanese, and African American. David said he has been told by several people about a prominent laundry woman in the area that was African American. He asked Lynne Orgill, with the Historical Society, about it and she wasn't sure

on the history. Nancy Nichols will ask if anyone has information on the Draper Do You Remember page on Facebook. David said there was a farm where Harmons is now that sold produce and Corina said she will ask about it.

3m. Historic Walking Tour Brochures

David stated he has placed 700 brochures. He gave some to the Director of American Preparatory Academy and she took folders and plastic holders. He has placed them at Cal Ranch, the library, the Draper Senior Center, IFA, and the Historical Society. Christa stated she took 30 to Summit Academy and Draper Park Middle School.

3a. Draper Historical Society Meeting

Jennifer stated that Wendy has created a sign in sheet for Historical Society meeting attendance but that she had heard from a couple people that they could not get onto the Draper Cloud to access it. Wendy asked Jennifer to help everyone learn how to log into the Draper Cloud and sign up on it. Jennifer gave an overview of the program and then stated she will email everyone out a link so they can access it. Bryn Johnson went to the meeting in May. Lynne said she was concerned about how they don't have a current history of Draper. They have a gap. They don't have a history about what the Commissions do. The Miss Draper group has created a historian position for their group. Bryn asked what we thought about that and David suggested that maybe Todd Shoemaker could do something like that. Annie suggested the Historical Society reach out to the State Office of Museums to get help. Corina will attend their meeting on the 24th of June.

3b. Guedelon

Nancy shared an article from NPR about a French castle named Guedelon that they have built using original methods from the 1300 century time period. Jennifer shared a video on YouTube she had found about it. It is a feature on CBS Sunday Morning. Annie suggested a field trip there.

3c. Reconnaissance Level Survey (RLS)

Jennifer stated she has no updates to provide she will continue to get with the Draper City Purchasing Agent on this.

3d. School Walking Tour Field Trip

Nancy stated that the field trip was canceled as the teachers decided they didn't have enough time and suggested we pick it up again in the fall. She will contact the teachers then to reschedule.

3e. Draper Days

The Commission discussed the impending tour and went over who from the Commission will be there to help. Those who will be helping: Nancy, Lynne, Angie, Annie, and Christa. Nancy and Angie will do the same houses and buildings they did last year and Annie will

do the ones Bryn did. They discussed having Lynne at the Draper Historic Park. Christa will be at the Sorensen House and the two west of it. Bryn asked if the city has a printing shop that can print signs for us. Corina will ask Lynne about opening up the Sorensen House the night of the tour. Jennifer reached out to the Draper Communications team and someone can be there to take pictures of the tour.

3f. National Register Nominations

Annie provided an updated from Mike Barnhill on the Fitzgerald Cabin plaque language. He could not find definitive dates on the Fitzgerald Cabin or the Burnham House so he went with what Korral Broschinsky had written and he adjusted the language to say "one of the oldest brick homes" He could not find information on the store that was run so he just kept it as "the store" and the language has been sent to Cory Jensen at the Utah State Historic Preservation Office. The State Board approved the Enniss Auto National Register nomination and they were very excited about it with very high praise for Korral's work and it is now on to National Register for approval.

3g. Walk-through Video Tour of Historic Homes

Nancy stated they are at a standstill on the Ware Home video but she talked to Kent Ware right before the meeting to see if she could get it moving. She will also go to the Crossgrove House as the owners have not replied to text messages or answered a call she made to them. She would like to ask them if they are interested in having a video done of the house.

3h. Walking Tour Addition

Nancy stated she has no updates on this as Jason was working on it.

3i. Women's Historical Contributions to Draper

10. Annie will do research with Wendy on Native Americans.
11. Annie will get an update from Jennifer on the RLS.
12. Corina will attend Historical Society meeting on June 24 and ask Lynne about doing the Draper Historical Park and opening the Sorensen Home for the Draper Days walking tour.
13. Nancy will get Ware walking tour video tour going and talk to Crossgrove house owners.
14. Christa will get a script together for Draper Days walking tour.
15. Jennifer will get the log in for the Draper Cloud out to the Commissioners.
16. Jennifer will ask where the city gets signage and let Angie know.
17. Jennifer to check on the progress of the RSL proposal.
