Logic & Accuracy is testing the equipment to ensure it is ready to be used and counting correctly.

Those wanting to vote must be registered.

EARLY VOTE:
Voters may visit the Clerk-Auditor's office, 8 am to 5 pm

Drop Boxes are available at the 3 City offices and the County bldg. during normal business hours. And a drive-thru at the Library open 24/7.

Ballots are processed as they come into the office, during normal business hours. Feel free to stop by and learn about the process.

County Building 7 am – 8 pm

The Audit is a random sample testing to ensure ballots were indeed counted correctly

The Canvass is the approval of the final results and includes all Ballots that were returned after the polls closed.

LOGIC and ACCURACY

Thursday, October 10th at 11 am.

- The Logic and Accuracy is how we make sure the Election Equipment is set up and prepared for the Election; ready to function properly.
- We have to make sure the ballots are also being counted correctly.

BALLOTS GO OUT!

Tuesday, OCTOBER 15

- Ballots will be mailed to ACTIVE voters.
 - If you aren't sure if you are registered or if your address may have changed, please
 - contact the Clerk-Auditor's office at 435-781-5360
 - OR go to vote.utah.gov

If you do not receive a ballot, please contact the office before October 29th if you want one mailed. Otherwise, stop in for Early Vote or on Election Day.

PROCESSING BALLOTS

Ballots are received and processed by the office as early as October 16th and up until Canvass, November 19th.

- Ballots are sorted into batches of 50 as they are received.
 - The signatures are then verified.
 - If the signature does not match, the voter is notified by letter and email.
 - The voter must return their cure affidavit if they want their ballot to be counted.
 - Signature verification is audited for consistency.
 - The signature tab is then removed from the envelope to ensure a secret ballot.
- Ballots are prepped for counting daily, once the signature is verified.
 - Envelopes are opened and the ballot removed, but kept in their batches.
 - The ballots are pressed flat and are taken to the counting room to be counted.
 - Counting may happen prior to Election Day – NO results are known until polls close at 8 pm on Election Day – NO exceptions.
- Ballots and cure affidavits received after Election night and before the Canvass will be processed for eligibility and counted, if possible.
 - Ballots postmarked after November 4th can't be counted.
 - If you are not confident the postmark will be on time, please take your ballot to the post office and request a date stamp. Or take it to a drop box.
 - Please review the drop box page for more information on drop box availability.

EARLY VOTE

- Voters may come to the Clerk-Auditor's office to Vote Tuesday, **October 22nd thru Friday November 1st**, during normal business hours, Mon - Fri, 8 am – 5 pm.
- You will need your ID and proof of residency if your address is not correct on your ID.



LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE

- If you want to vote for the 2024 General Election you will want to be registered to vote no later than October 25th.
- Vote.Utah.gov
- If you miss this deadline, you may register to vote and vote at the same time on Election day via a Provisional ballot.
 - However, if your ID or address can't be verified, your ballot may not be counted.

DROP BOXES

Once ballots go out, [drop boxes](#) will be available.

- Each City has a drop box available during normal business hours.
 - Ballard City: Monday thru Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm
 - Naples City: Monday thru Thursday, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm
 - Vernal City: Monday thru Friday, 8 am to 5 pm
 - The County Building: Monday thru Friday, 8 am to 5 pm
- A drive-thru drop box is available at the County Library, open 24/7, until 8 pm on Election day.



On Election Day, November 5th

- the drop boxes will be gathered up a little before their building closes and then will not be an option for you.
- At 8 pm, when the polls close, the drive-thru drop box at the Library will be locked.
- Ballots must be received by 8 pm on Election Day.

ELECTION DAY!!!

- There will be one polling location on Election Day. Located at the County Building. There will be two lines available.
- Hours are 7 am to 8 pm.
- Bring your ID and proof of residency if the address is wrong on your ID.



The AUDIT

Wednesday, November 13th at 9 am.

- We will be auditing the equipment and the Election as a whole.
- We want to ensure everything has been done correctly.
- We also want to ensure the ballots have been counted accurately.

CANVASS

Tuesday, November 19th at 3 pm. In conjunction with Commission Meeting.
