### Consolidate and Improve County Jail

- Expand Adult Detention Center (ADC) to meet population growth and capacity needs
- Increase rehabilitative services and mental health resources
- Close Oxbow, transfer inmates and services to expanded jail/ADC
- Location: 3415 South 900 West, South Salt Lake







## Justice and Accountability Center

- Cost effective alternative to jail for low level offenders
- Balance accountability with resources/real solutions (behavioral —mental health and substance use disorder, medical, job training, housing, etc.)
- Connected to criminal justice system
- Location: TBD (several county -owned parcels are available near the Adult Detention Center/jail)







### Investment in Community and Public Safety



- Reduce crime
- Improve accountability
- Connect with resources/real solutions



- Break the cycle of repeat offenses
- County population has grown yet no jail beds have been added since 2001
- Cost effective/fiscally conservative and responsible



- Integral part of Salt Lake County's Human Services, Homelessness, and Criminal Justice Reform Action Plan
- Bipartisan 8 -1 Salt Lake County vote to move it to the ballot



Supported by majority of community members surveyed



# Taxpayer Savings from Justice and Accountability Center Investment



- Jail: \$136/day per person —\$49,640/annually
- Justice and Accountability Center: \$75/day per person —\$27,500/annually
- SAVINGS: \$60/day per person —\$22,500 less per person annually

County Set Aside	(100,000,000)
TOTAL	\$507,000,000

Impact: Residence = \$4.91/month (based on average property value of \$602,000)

Business = \$8.93/month
