14.1. Approve: Capital Development Priorities for Fiscal Year 2025-26 (Presenters: Dave Cowley)

Vice President Cowley presented the Capital Development Priorities for the fiscal year 2025-2026. He explained USU's first priority will be the remodel of the "Math and Stats" building on the Quad which is now referred to as MAIDAC-Math, AI, Data and Analytics Center. The university had to rethink the renovation and is now planning to do an addition instead of just a remodel. VP Cowley added USU would like to begin Phase 1 on a Spectrum renovation with a plan to present three additional phases at a later date.

Vice President Dave Cowley shared the attached slides of the final 2024-2025 athletic budgets, both for USU Logan as well as USU Eastern. He touted Vice President and Athletic Director Diana Sabau for her efforts as Athletics ended fiscal year 2024 in the black for the first time in what could be remembered. Athletics will have approximately \$400,000-500,000 to roll over and are projecting \$1.25 million surplus at the end of 2025.
