RESOLUTION 2024-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY BOARD ADOPTING THE SKYLINE CORRIDOR INLAND PORT PROJECT AREA PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-58-301(1) Utah Code Annotated as amended (“UCA”), the Utah Inland Port Authority (“Authority”) is “governed by a board which shall manage and conduct the business and affairs of the Authority”; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-58-501(2a) UCA, the “The board may adopt a project area plan for land that is outside the authority jurisdictional land;”; and

WHEREAS, the Authority board desires to create the Skyline Corridor Inland Port Project Area and adopt a new project area plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY BOARD as follows:

1. The Authority board has found and determined that the Skyline Corridor Inland Port project area plan meets the statutory requirements that include the legal description of the boundary of the project area, the purpose and intent with respect to the project area and the board’s finding and determination that
 - a. there is a need for the project to effectuate a public purpose;
 - b. there is a public benefit to the proposed Skyline Corridor Inland Port project;
 - c. it is economically sound and feasible to adopt and carry out the project area plan; and
 - d. carrying out the Skyline Corridor Inland Port project area plan will promote the goals and objectives stated in Subsection §11-58-203(1) UCA.
2. The Authority board hereby: (i) approves the creation of the Skyline Corridor Inland Port project area; and (ii) adopts the Skyline Corridor Inland Port project area plan effective on October 7, 2024.
