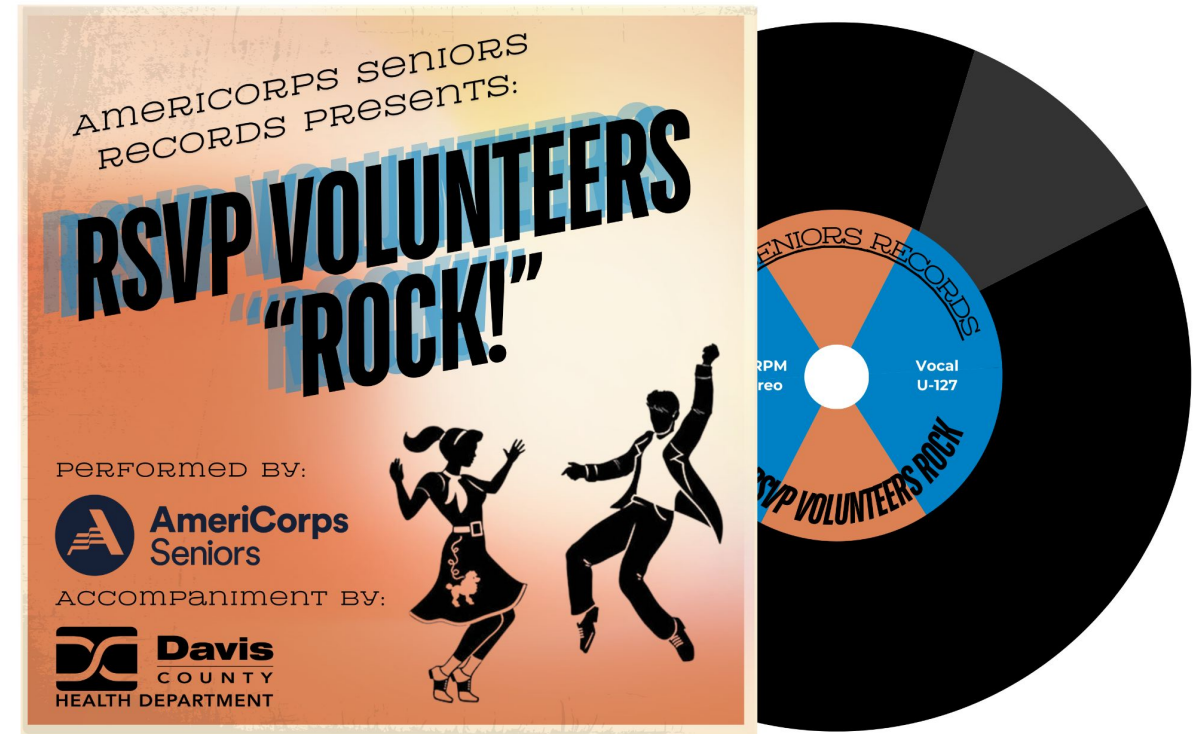

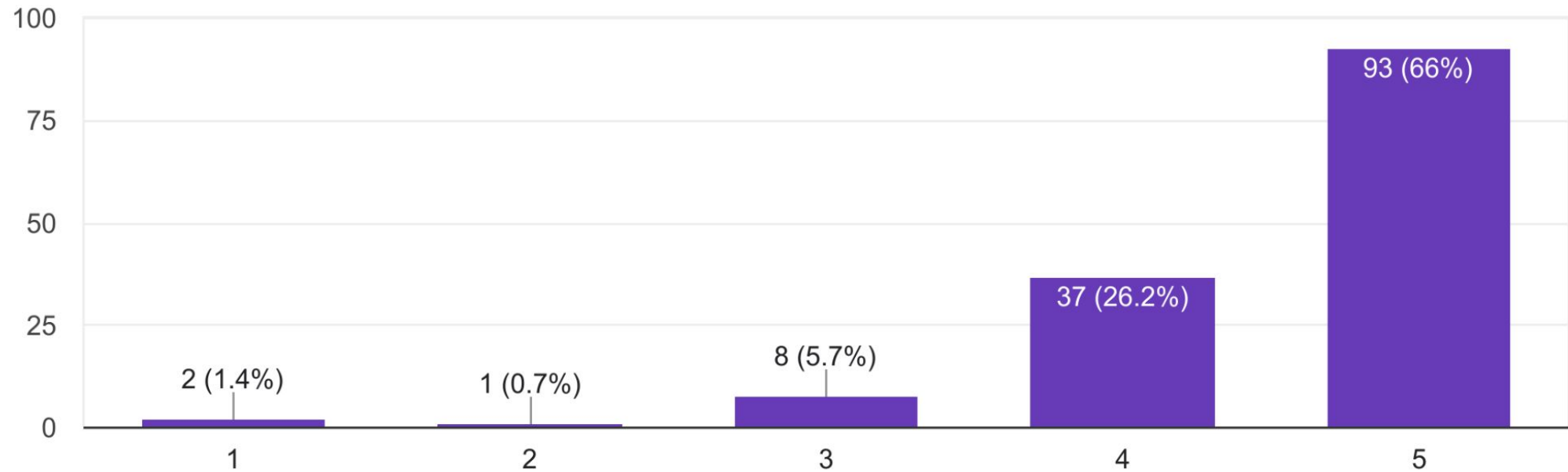
- 281 volunteers invited

Rate your satisfaction with the location of the event. 1= Very Unsatisfied 5= Very Satisfied

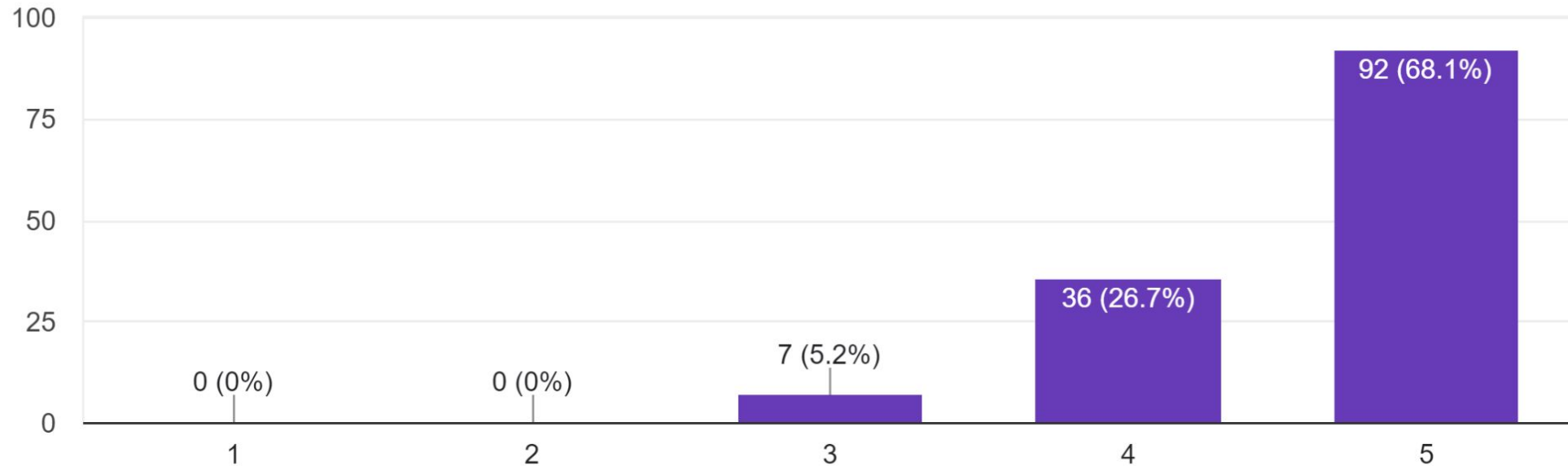

Rate your satisfaction with the entertainment provided during the event. 1= Very Unsatisfied 5= Very Satisfied

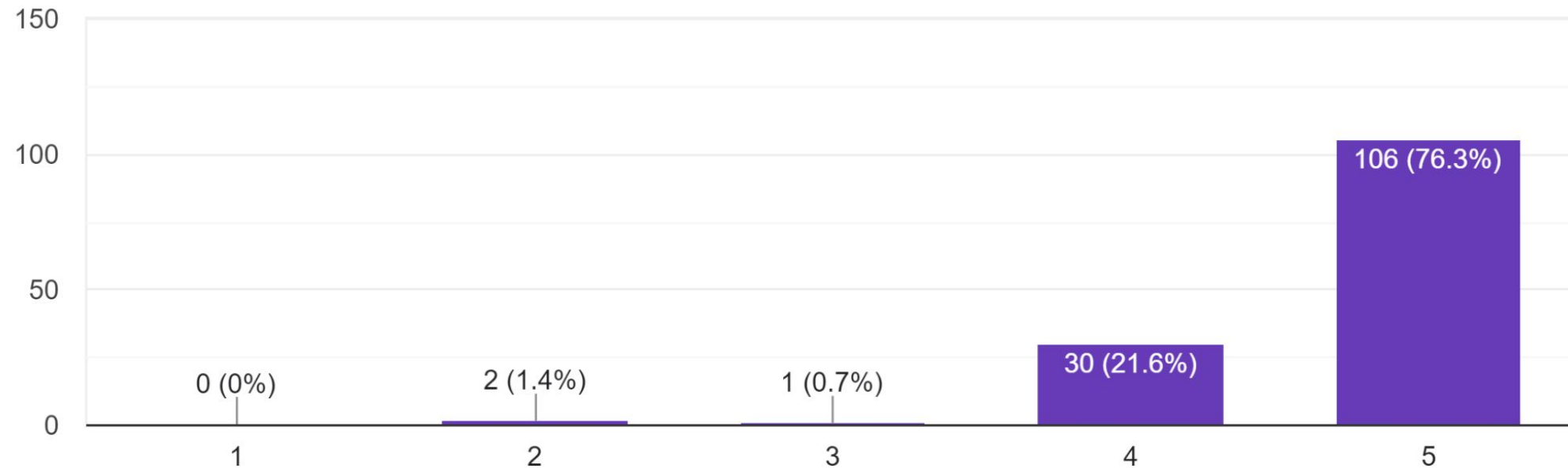

Rate your overall satisfaction with the event. 1= Very Unsatisfied 5= Very Satisfied

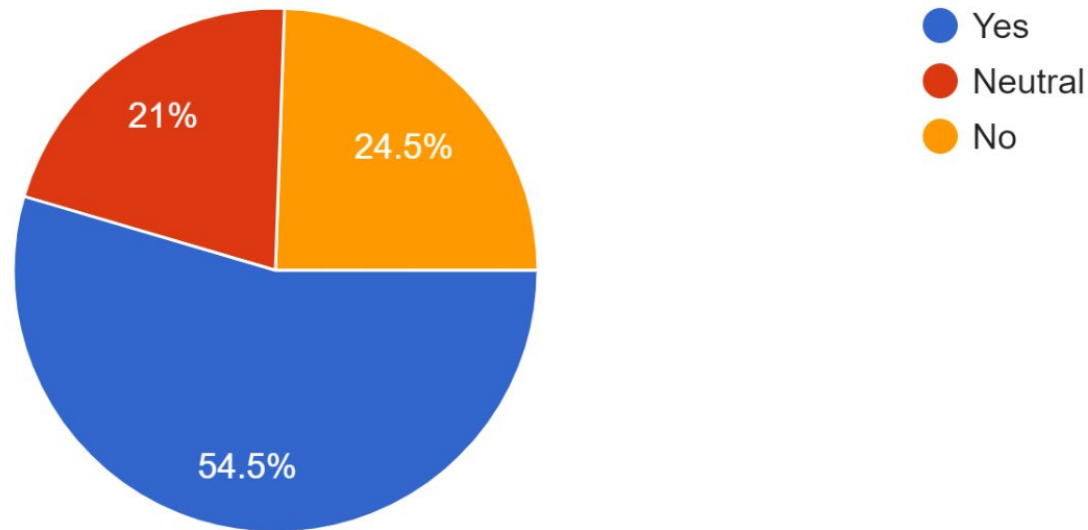

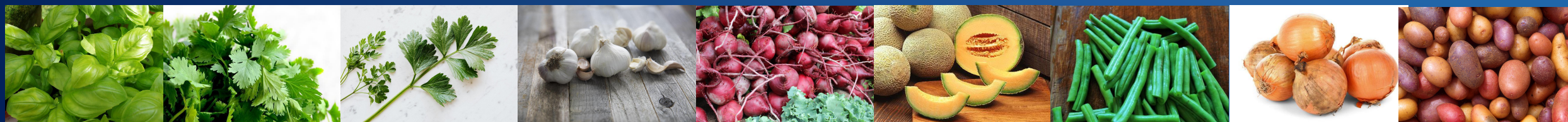

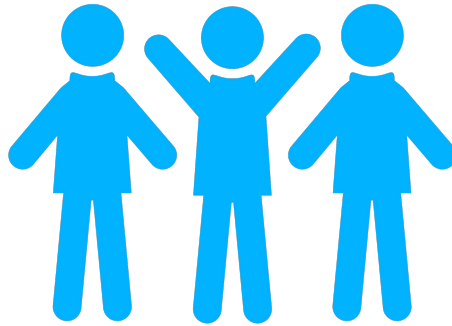

Services

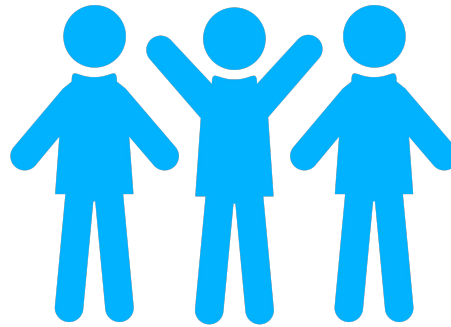

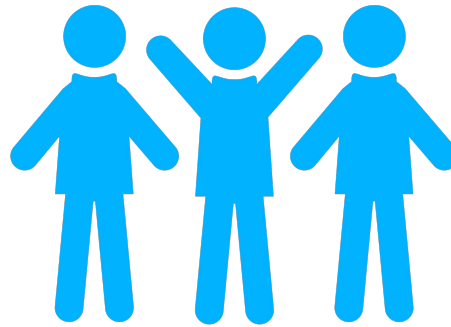

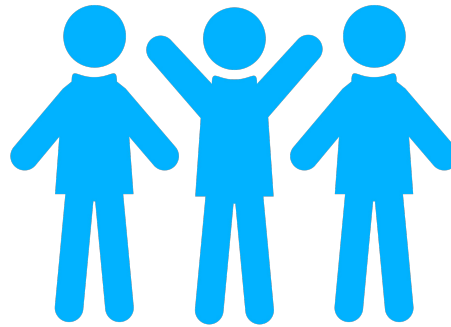
