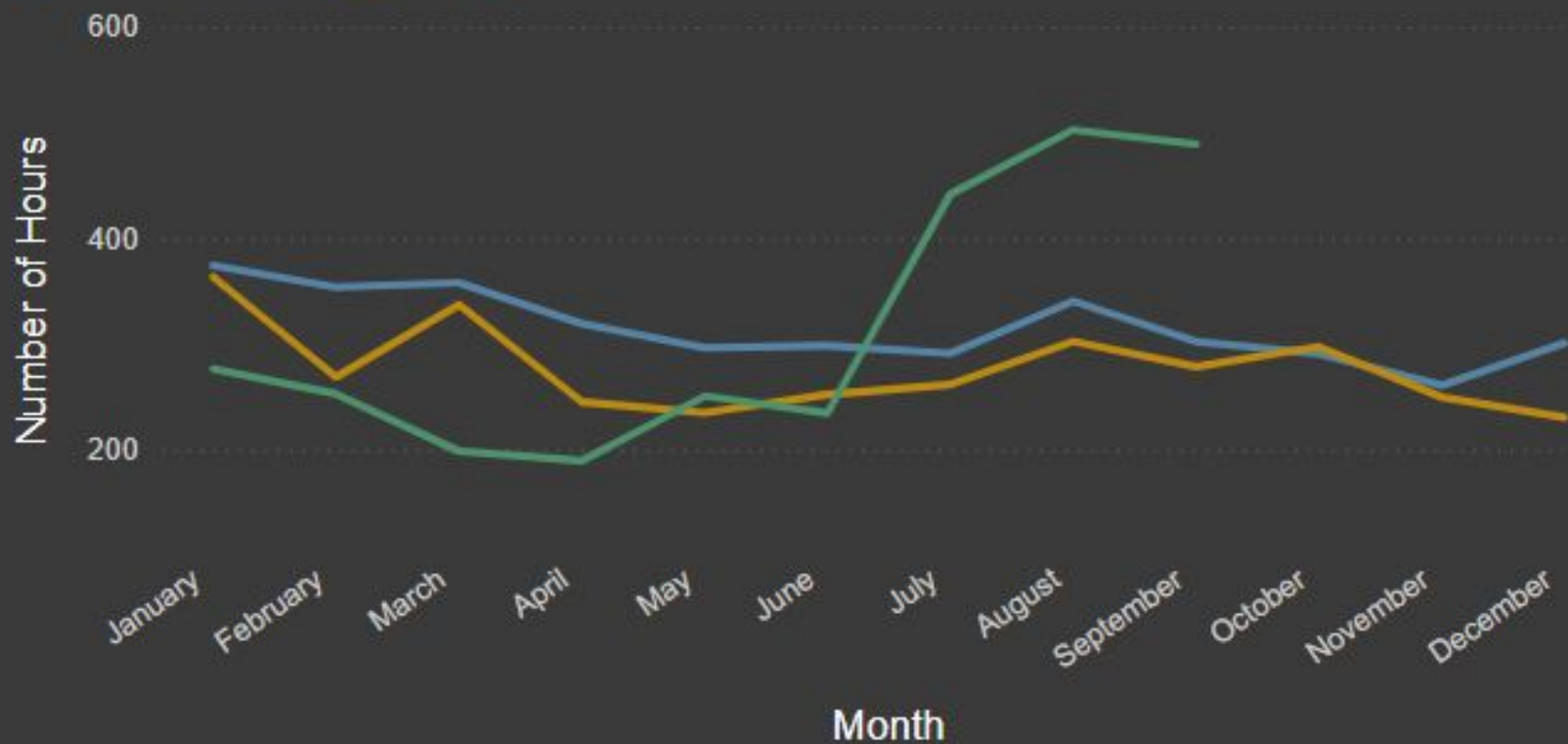

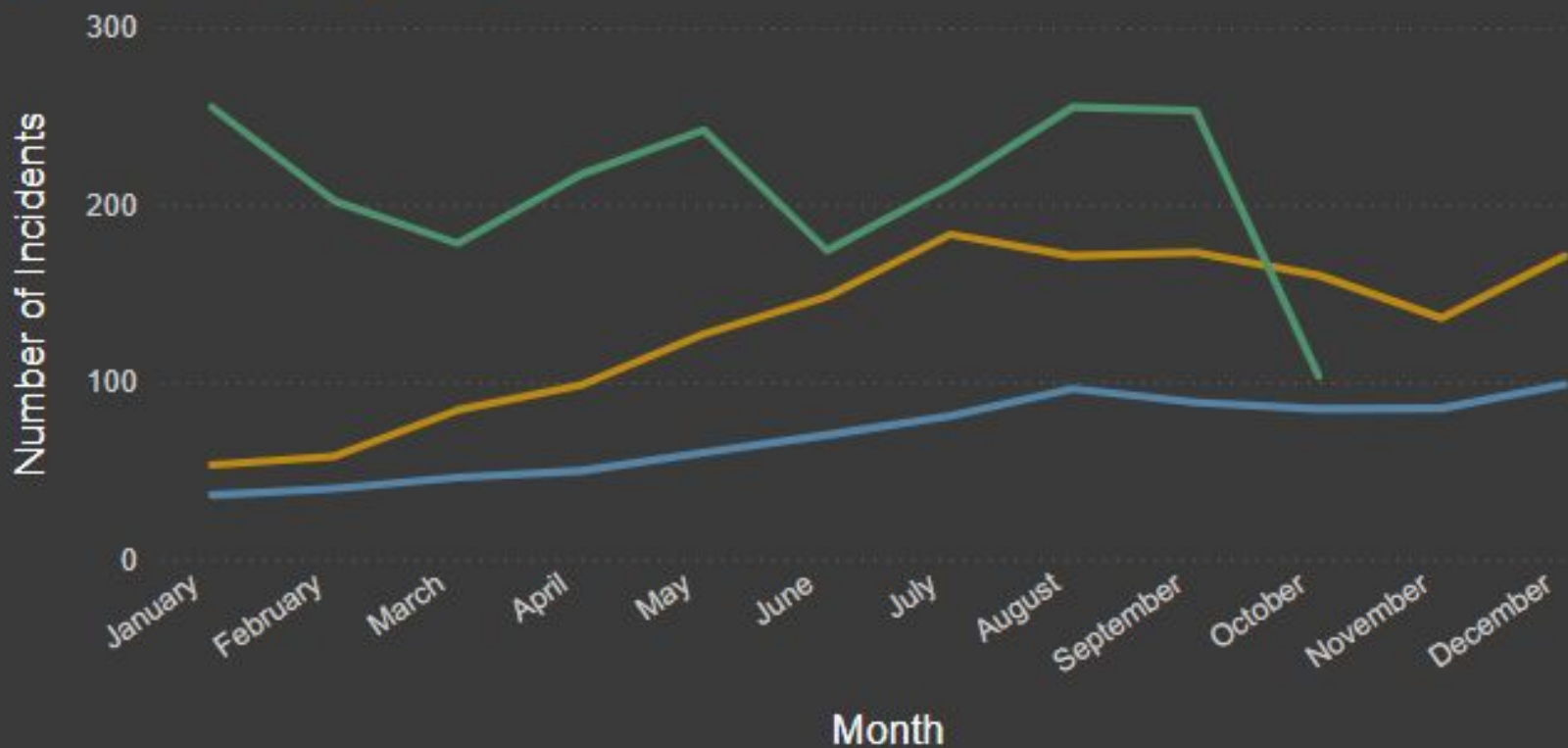
Patrol Hours

● Three Year Average ● 2023 ● 2024



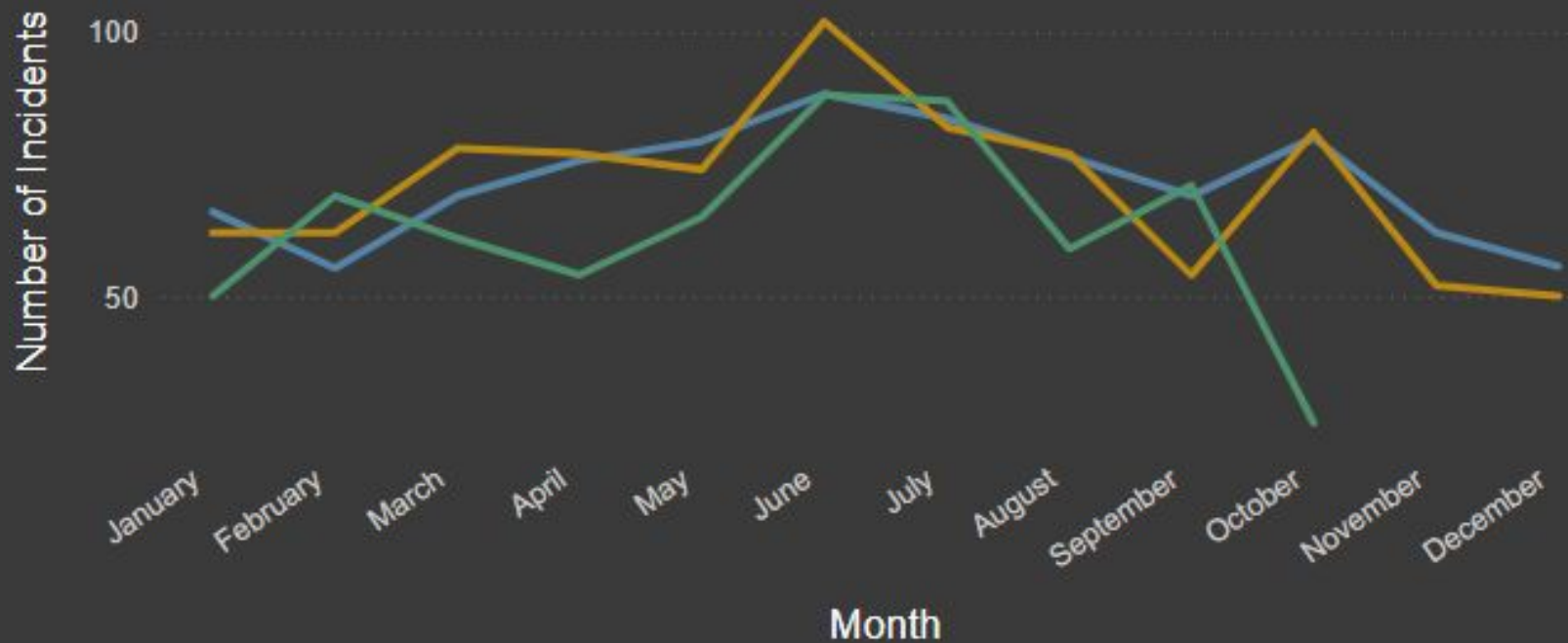
Field Initiated Incidents

● Three Year Average ● 2023 ● 2024



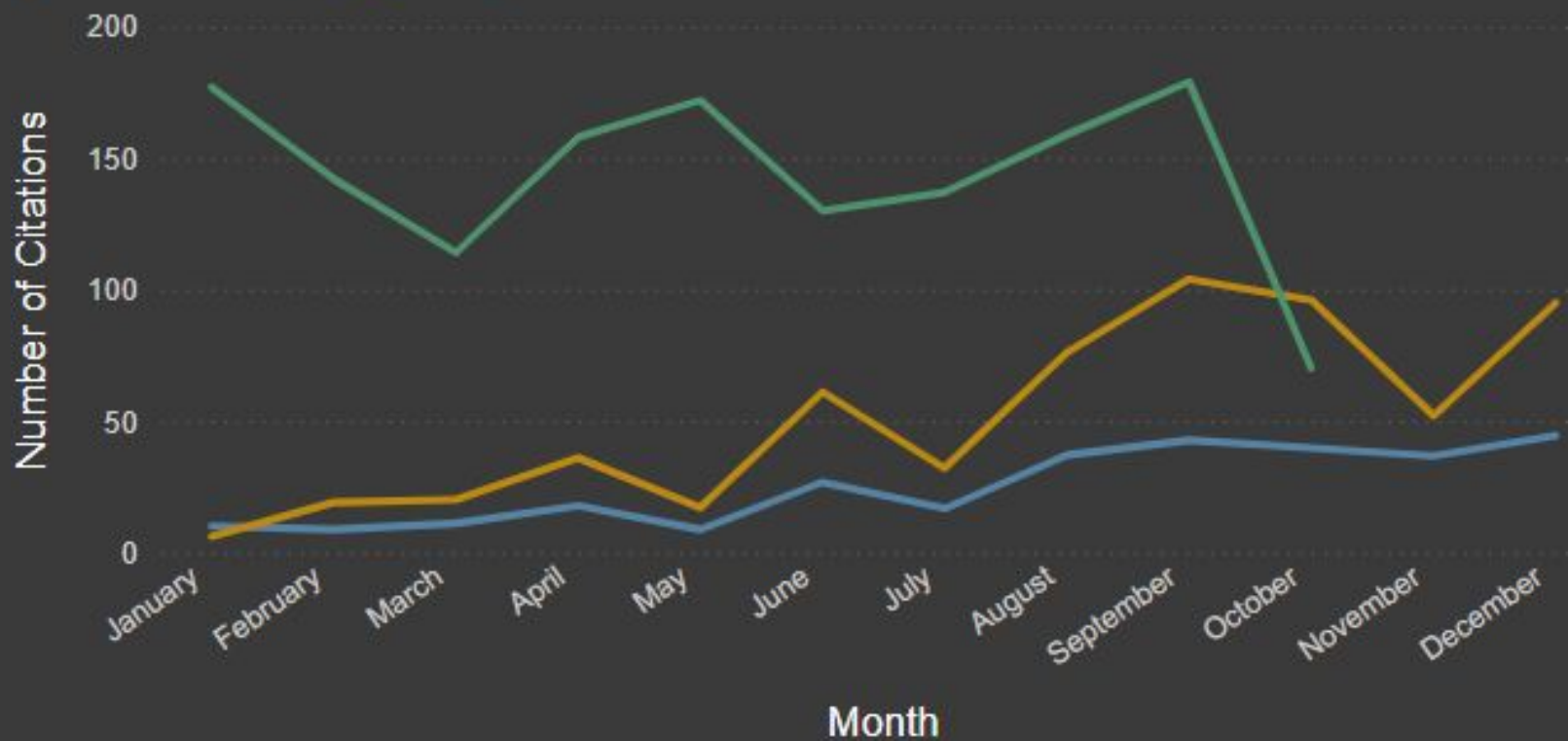
Dispatched Incidents

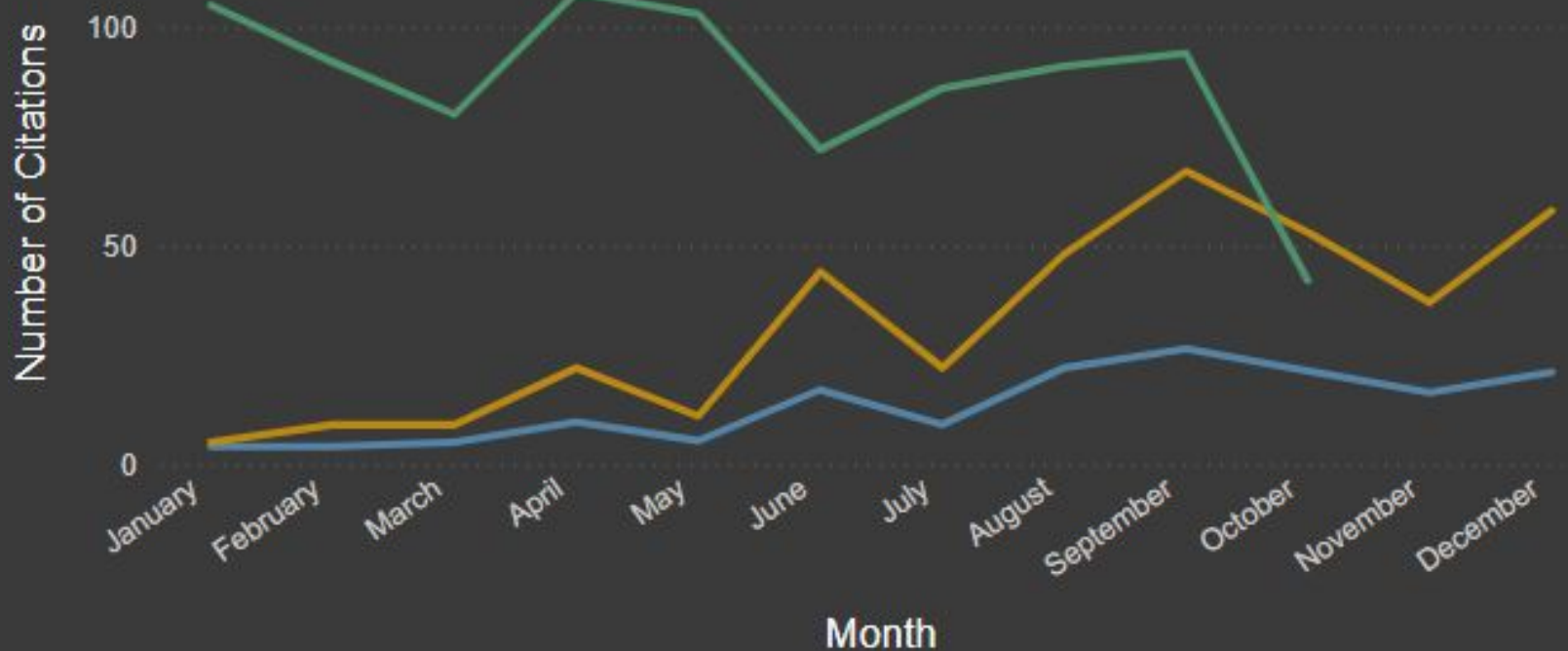

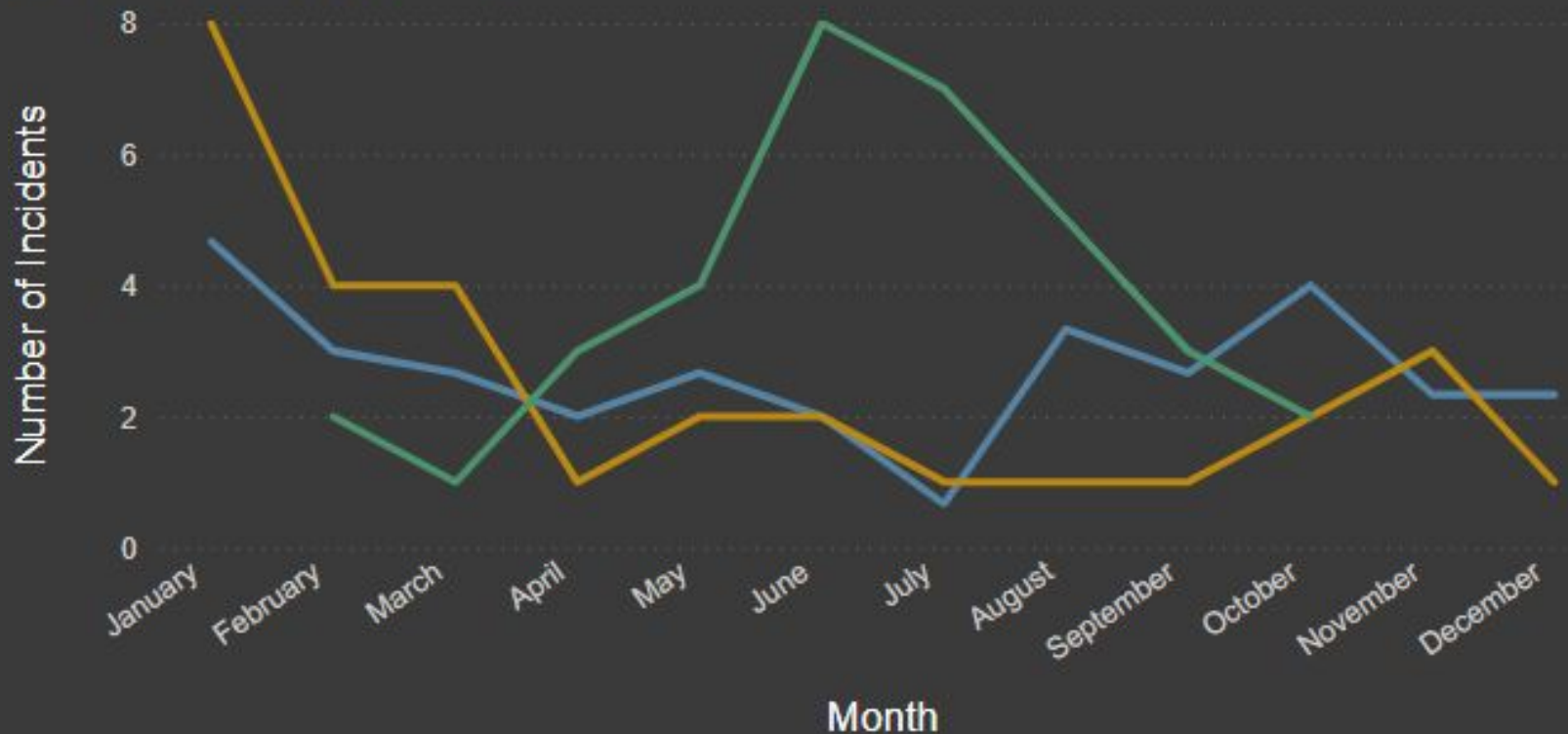
Speeding

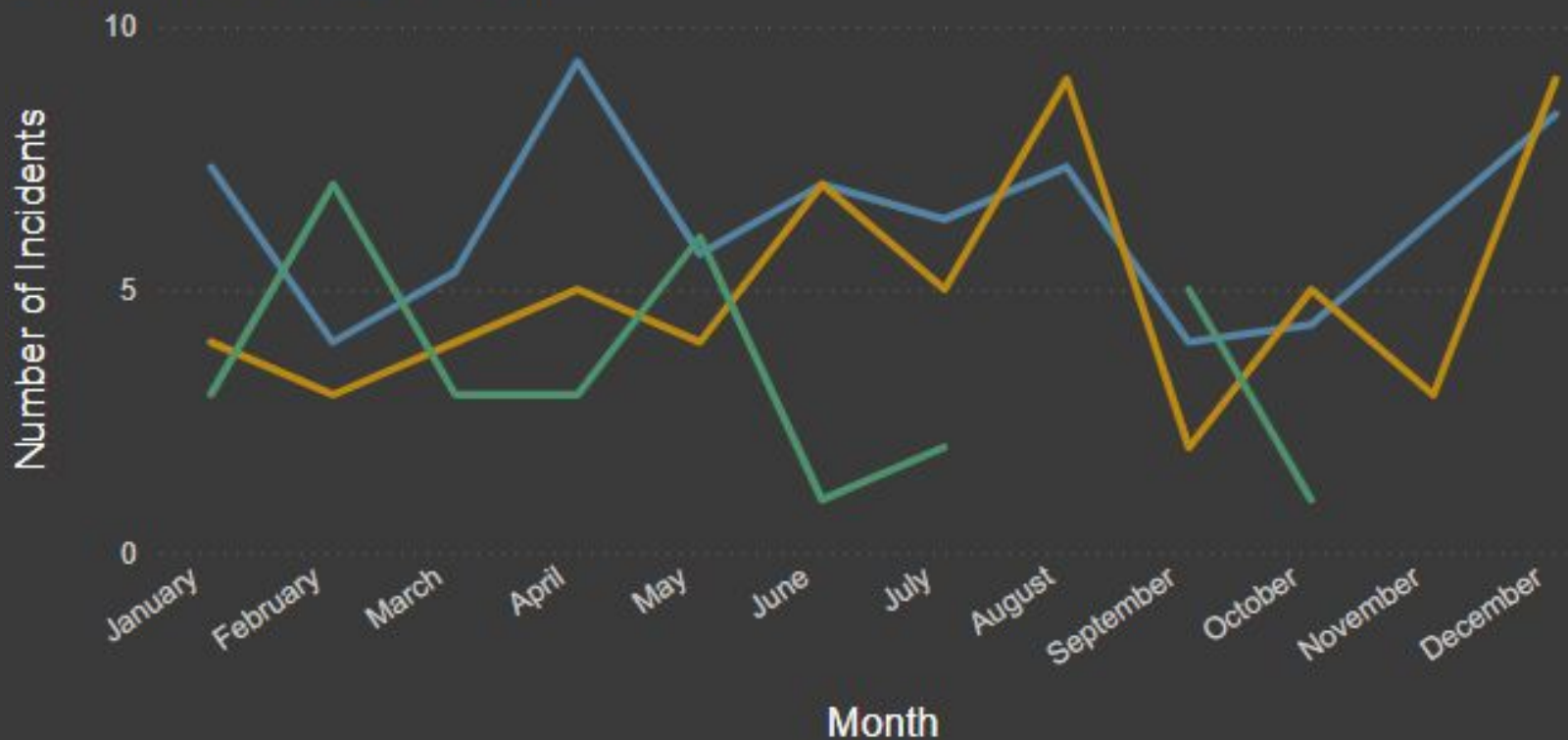
Person Crimes

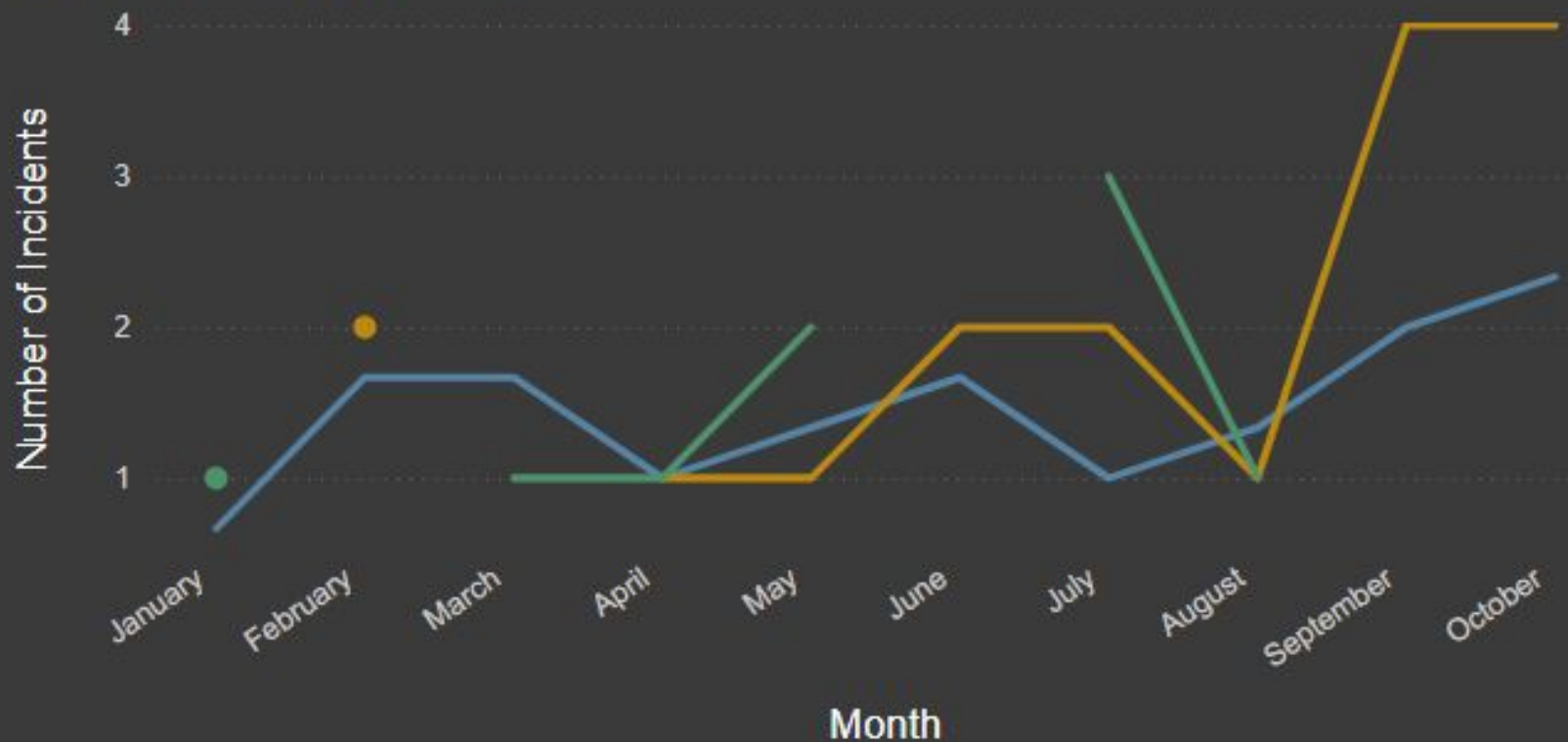
Property Crimes

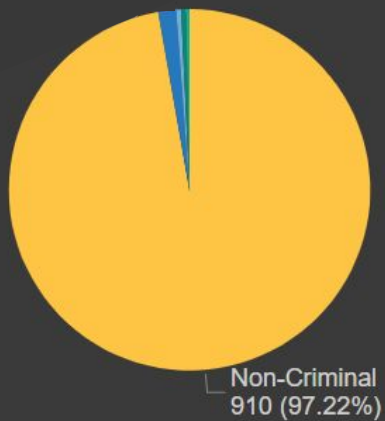

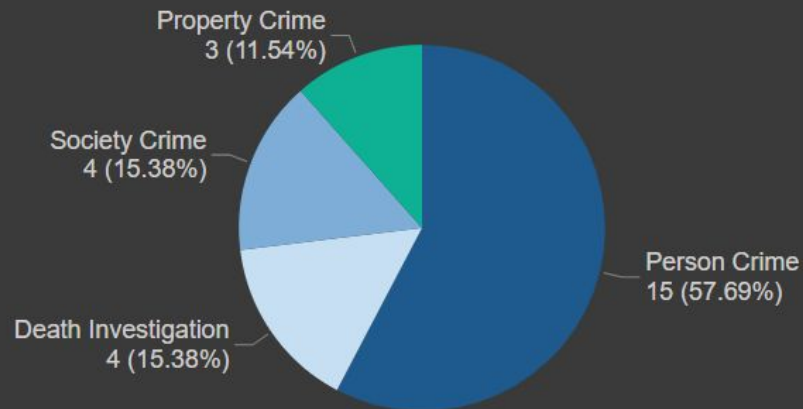

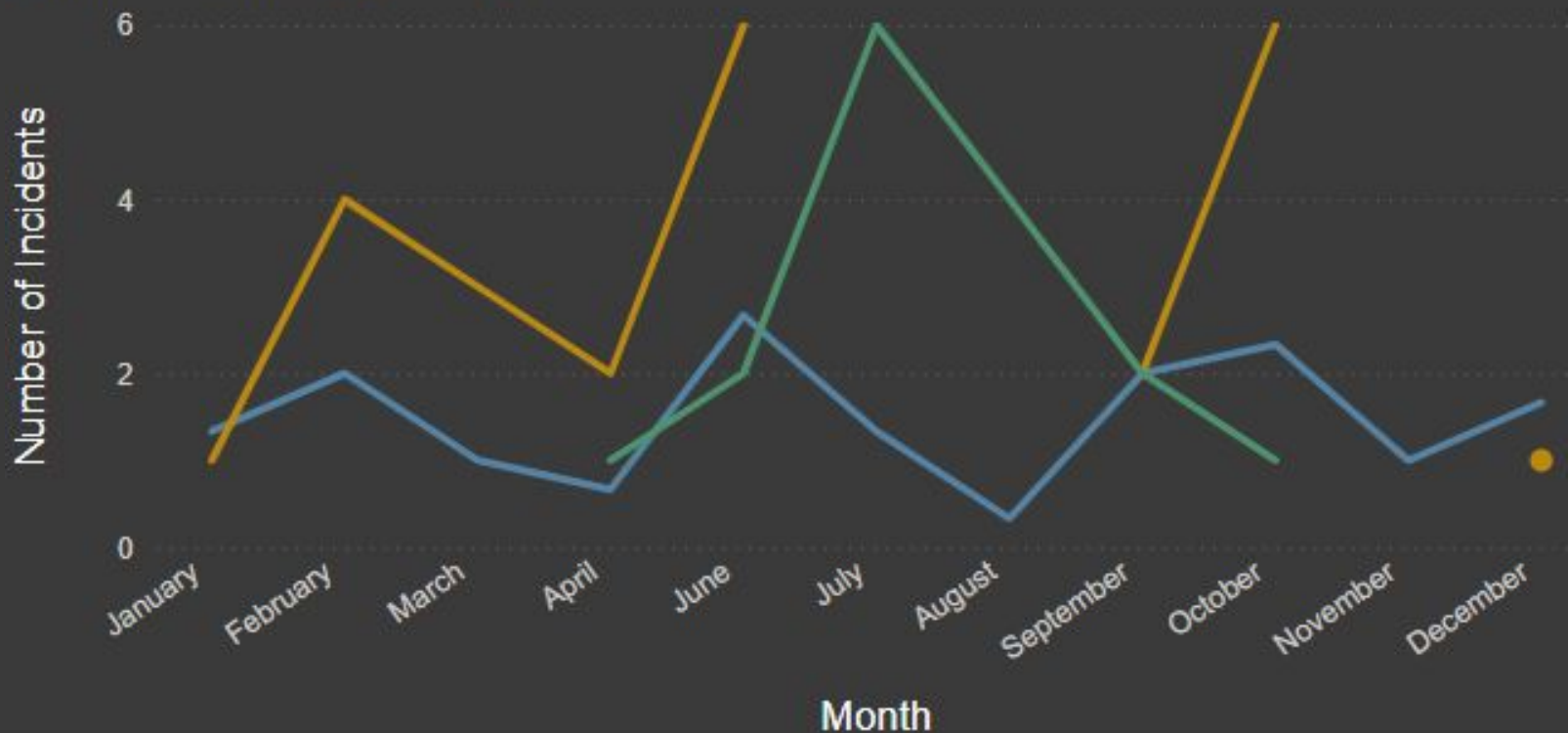

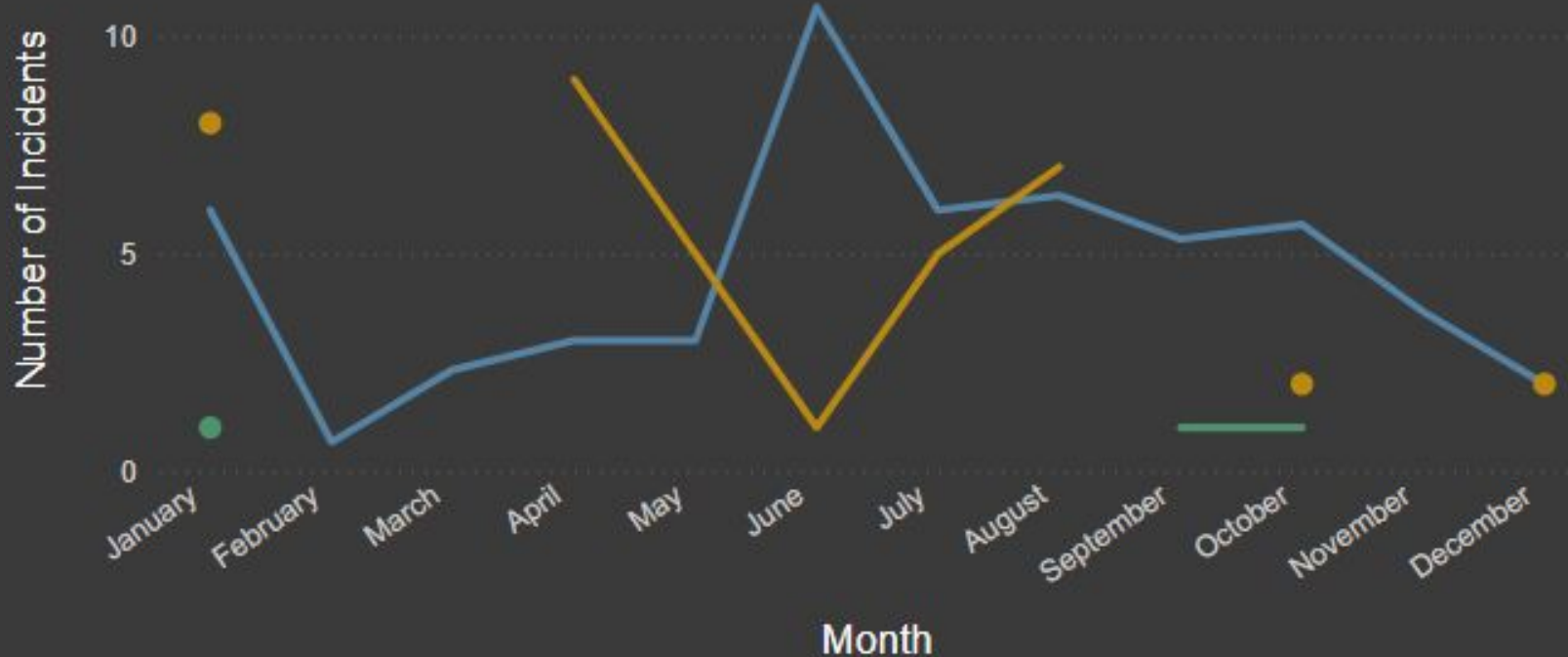
Person Crimes

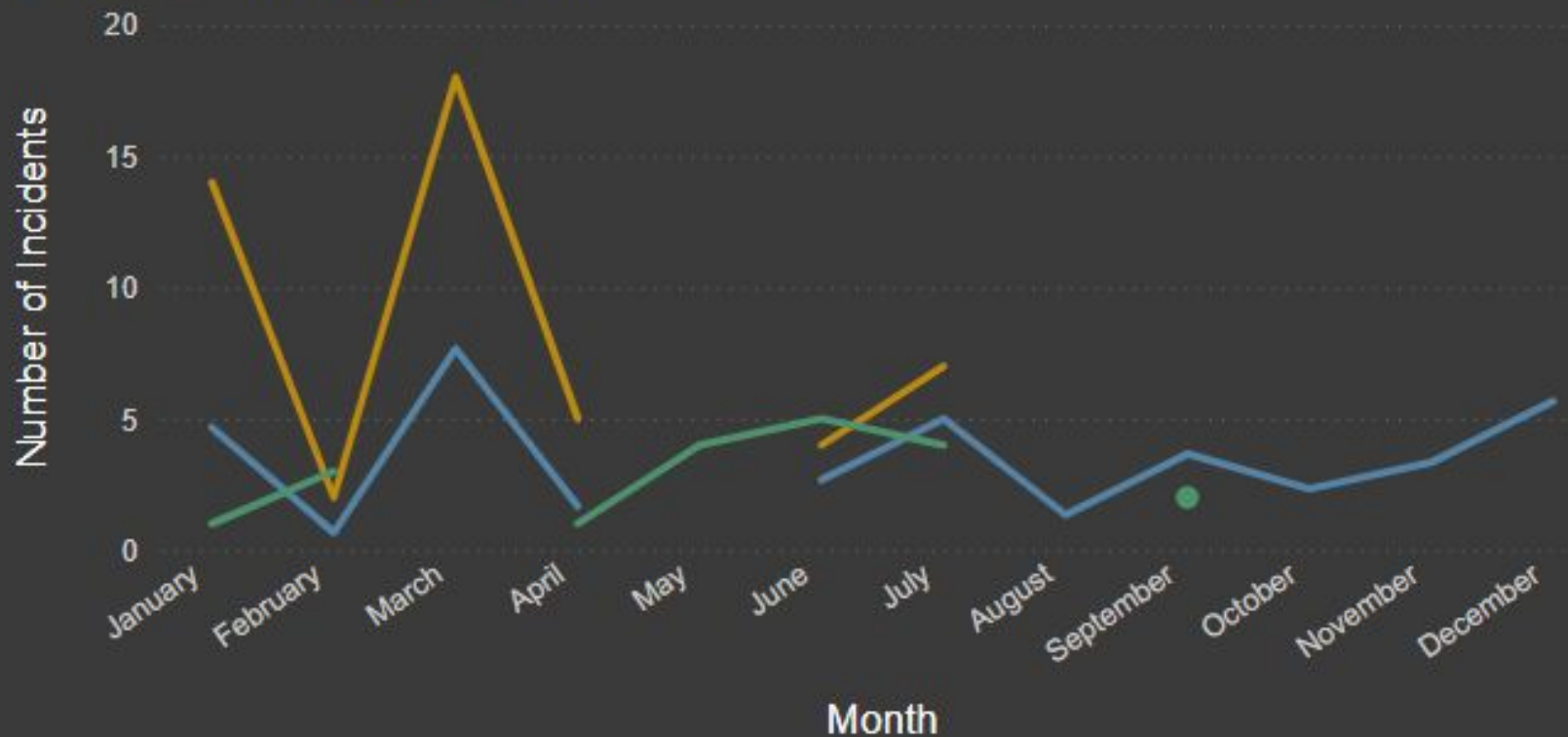
Property Crimes

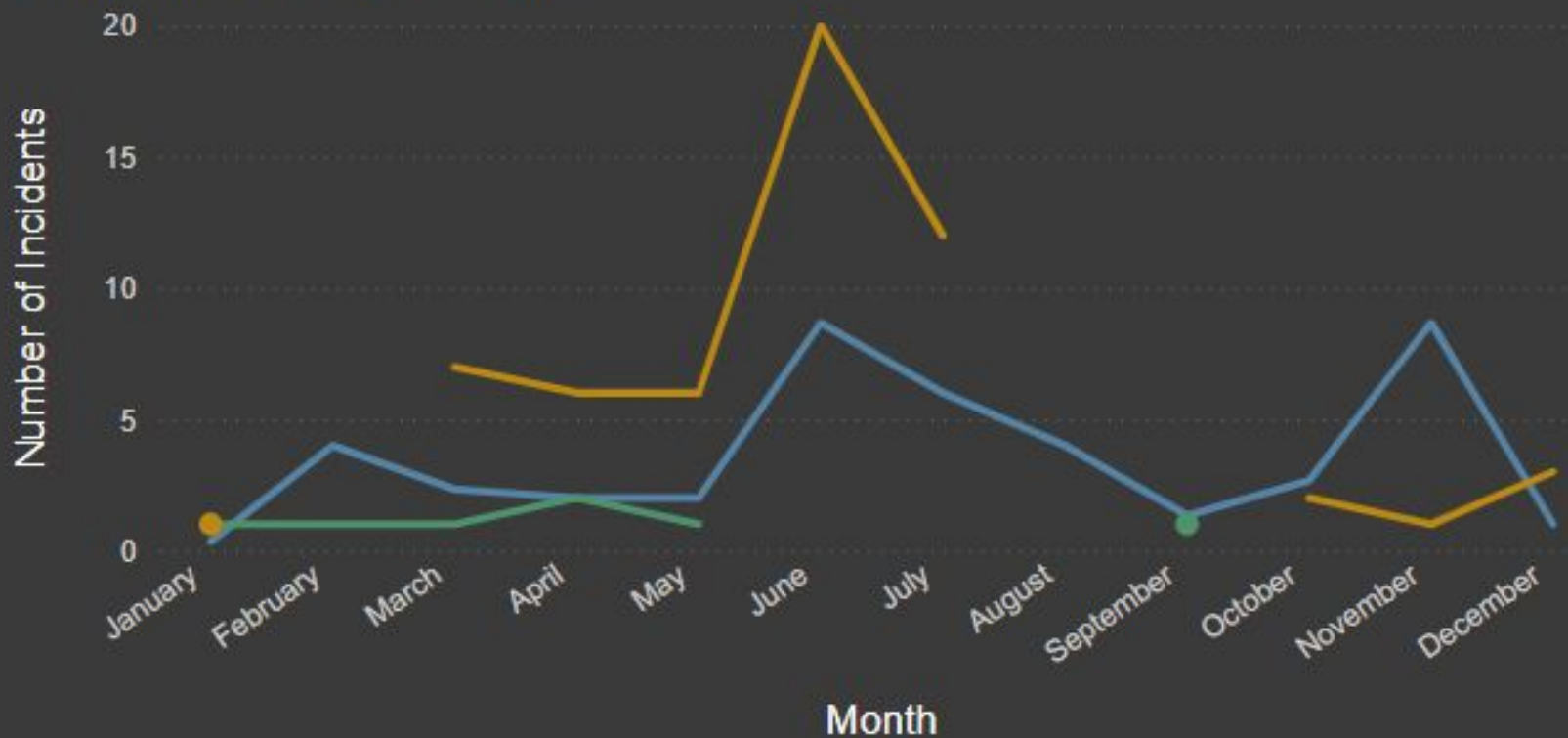
Special Victims Unit Crimes

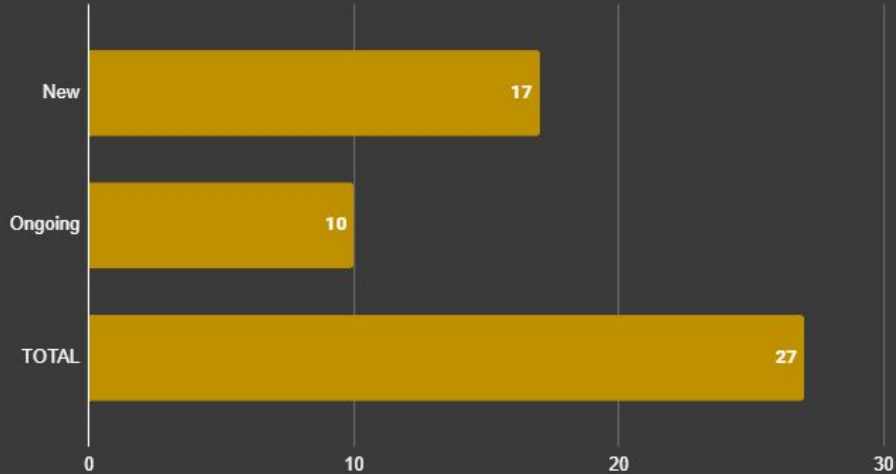

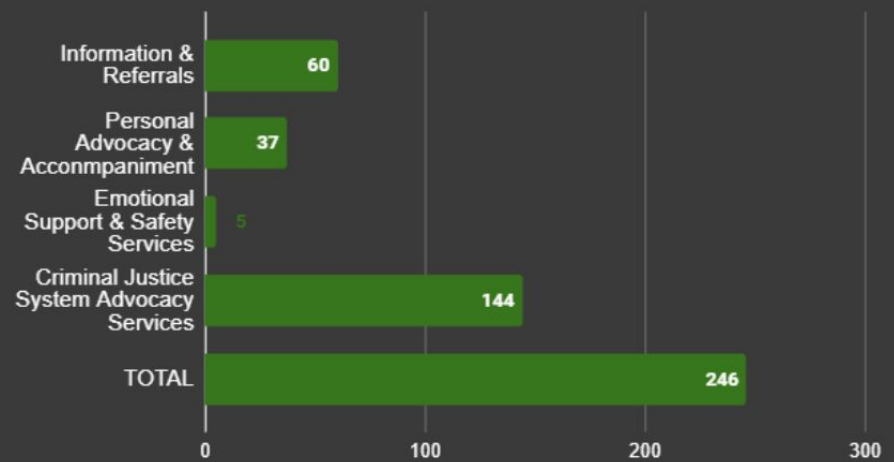

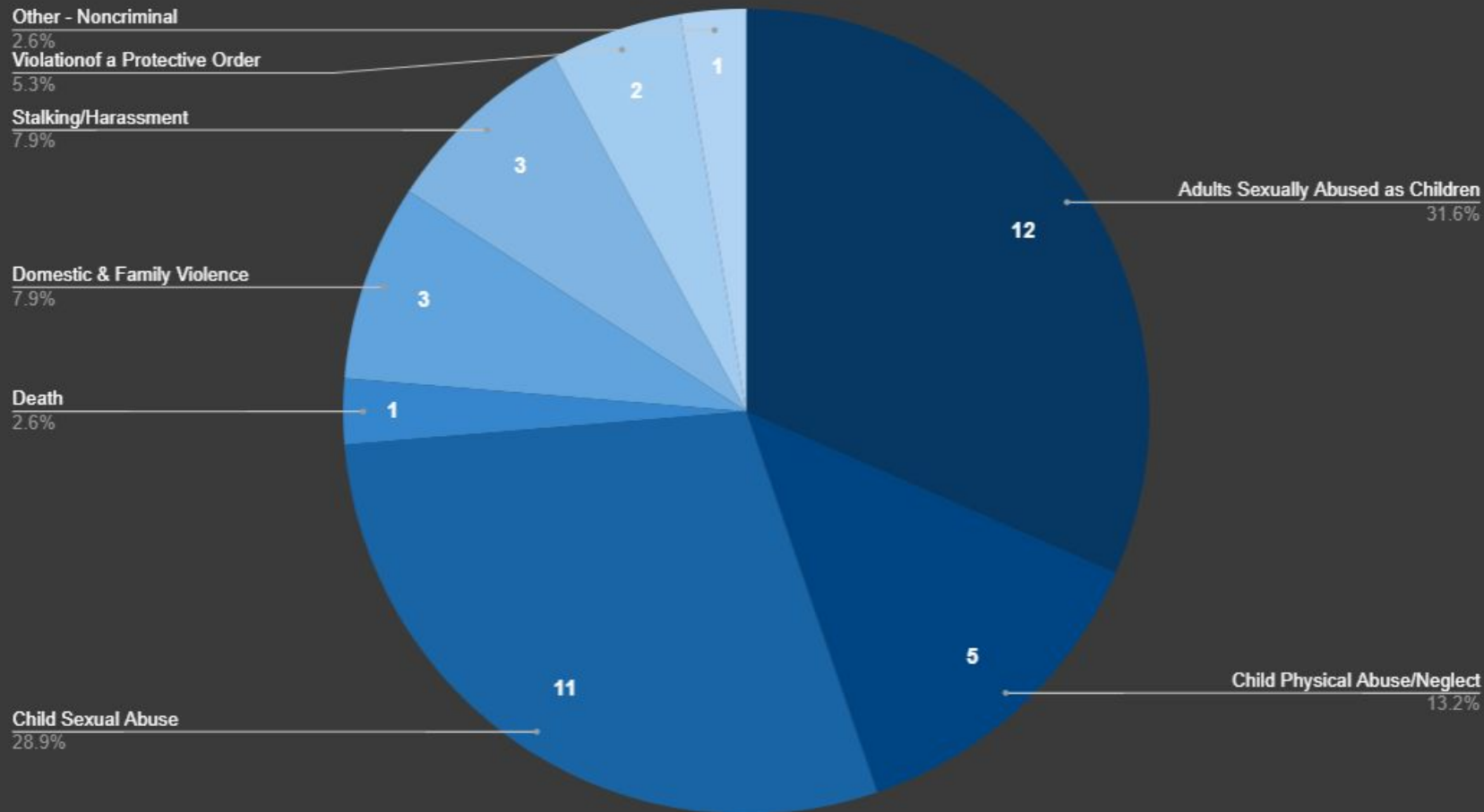
