Welcome Back Board Members:

- Welcome back everyone!!
- Unfortunately, Kaycee Hunt's last term ends in October.
- Melissa Giddings has been appointed new Ladies' President.

Approval of Minutes:

- Rick Johnson made a motion to approve the May Golf Advisory Board Meeting. Carol Denniston seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

Finance Report:

- Dawn provided the Financial Report for the course to date.
- There was \$85,000 in interest earned this year
- General Transfers are at \$33,000
- City provides funds for IT, garbage service, etc. Ends up balancing out.
- Dawn has asked Gloria for hours analysis report for part-time employees.
- Report will allow Dawn to prepare a proposal for full-time equivalent staff for next fiscal year.
- Date changes such as leap years and tournament dates affect revenue.
- Best months for revenue are those with 5 2-day weekends.

Women's Association Report:

- Kaycee has won the Ladies' Championship
- The weather affected the turnout this year.
- Closing social coming up next month.
- 88 paid members, approximately a 75% turnout each week.

- Would like to discuss another tee this winter as there have been some incidents in the Women's over 70 flights
- Westfield High School has been added to the region.

Men's Association Report:

- Just finished up Club Championship on Wednesday
- Had 3 regular flights and 1 senior flight with 14 participants.
- Rick Johnson has made it to the finals.
- Some newer members do not come play as often.
- A month and a half out from closing social.

Update on No.1 Green Cart Path:

- It has been completed. Filling in with some sod and seed.
- Looks great.

Driving Range Improvement (Tee Area Plan)

- Staff met earlier this week on the range to discuss improvement plan
- Dustin was invited to the meeting for plan.
- Concrete ribbon on back of range area was discussed.
- Jeff passed around picture of Glenmore's range for reference.
- Uses a sport-like/turf type material. Can use tees on it.
- New concrete around dispenser shed will be included as well as ADA access from front of ball dispenser.
- Poplar trees on either side of dispenser shed will need to be removed to provide access to tee area and crosswalk. Trees are in bad shape and new trees will be planted.
- Looking for a way to keep range open during construction.
- Path will be approximately 10-15 ft wide.
- Contractor used for cart path repairs will try to make time for driving range improvement project.
- Randy would like to repair cart path around No.5

Replacement Netting to be Ordered:

- Currently taking a count of netting to be ordered.
- In the process of pricing out product. Cost would be approximately \$10,000 for all nets and extras to keep on hand.
- Vendor in Seattle has been supplier in the past.
- Once bids are received, will present to City Council to draw funds from reserve.

- Netting seems to be on a 5-year cycle for replacement.

Golf Professional Report:

- Cache Valley Getaway had 88 ladies sign up (44 teams)
- Fall on the River has 35 teams signed up. Allows up to 60 teams. Fundraiser for juvenile diabetes.
- 2 High School boy matches in September
- Finally got Tournament Room window fixed.
- Driving range is always busy compared to other courses in the area.
- Bought 15 new rent sets. Most go out daily. \$15 to rent.

Golf Superintendent Report:

- 2 years in a row that No. 5 green gives him issues. Has applied fungicide and other materials on the area and hasn't helped. Still working on the issue.
- Will treat for nematodes next.
- Students starting to go back to school, looking for help to end the season. Still needs staff for fall applications and winterization.
- Staff mows approximately 300 acres a week.

Open Forum:

- Tutus for Tatas raised and donated \$7500 to Intermountain Regional Hospital
- Dawn wanted to follow up on hole sponsorships- No new sponsors have come forward and current sponsors have not renewed sponsorship. Jeff still waiting for Schreiber's logo for their spot.
- Jeff would like to show golf at the Pro Shop all day along with Sponsor ads.
- Any recommendations for the open chair coming up in October, send to Jeff or Russ.
- Aidan Tueller was recommended as he is now past president.
- Dawn's last term ends June 2025.
- Russ will propose a subcommittee to the Mayor for marketing purposes
