Arguments For the Tax:

- The PARAT tax will provide funding to develop Parks, Arts, Recreation, Aquatics, and Trails programs and facilities for the benefit of all Clearfield residents for a period of 10 years.
- These projects will enhance the quality of life in Clearfield.
- It would be funded through purchases by both residents and non-residents.
- The burden of the tax is very low—just one penny (\$0.01) for every \$10.00 of eligible purchases. Motor fuel, grocery food, and food ingredients are exempt from the tax.
- The PARAT Tax is a dedicated funding source which allows other general City revenues to be used for other needs such as road maintenance and construction, snow removal and public safety.
- Revenue generated by the PARAT tax may be used to enhance the development of the new community park to be built at Clearfield Station by our FrontRunner stop, along with other important projects throughout the City.
