

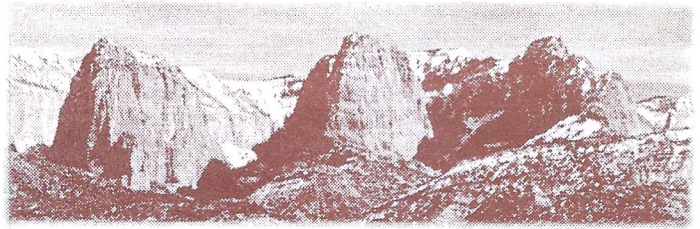
TOWN OF NEW HARMONY

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Minutes June 5, 2024 7:30 p.m.

Those in attendance: Mayor Prince, councilmembers Larsen, Allen, Batty, and Pace.

Call to Order

Open Hearing –

1. Misty from Hinton Burdick Accounting explained the budget for fiscal year 2025. Asked about use of impact fees and line item for remodel of post office.
2. Public meeting closed

Council meeting open

1. Motion to accept the budget for fiscal year 2025 made by Larsen, 2nd by Pace. Unanimous vote.
2. Allie Aland – presented her plans for remodeling her existing home. Planning Commission explained the need to revise town ordinances. Motion to accept the plans made by Larsen, 2nd by Allen. Unanimous.
3. Lot line adjustment for Brian McCoy. Motion to accept made by Batty, 2nd Pace. Unanimous vote.
4. 4th of July – Sadie Ellis presented the plans for the day. Asked the mayor to be the Grand Marshal. Larsen will get the stoves ready the night before. Council happy with their organization. Chris Peterson will perform on the June 28th.

5. General Plan Survey - Presented by Clerk. Motion to accept by Allen, 2nd by Larsen. Unanimous.
6. Reports – Allen – wants to paint the restroom at trailhead. Told that they can go ahead and paint. Batty – turned the well on. Larsen – had another company give a bid for asphalt for roads. SC Communications will be starting on the install of internet. Wants a contingency plan to turn water off in the ~~even~~ ^{event} of problems. Pace will be ready. Pace – nothing. Mayor – got a bid for asphalt for parking lot at post office. Bids from \$23,000 to \$25,000. Wants town board to decide to do it now or wait. Council will be willing to have the parking lot asphalted.
7. Other – Sadie Ellis – concerned about people speeding through town. Mayor talked to the Washington County Road guy. There seems to be concern about liability for the town. Council is working on trying. John Southwick. Special Service District – needs to establish a committee for wild land fire prevention. Committee would be tasked to education community members about fire mitigation. Looking for committee members. Asking town members that are interested to participate. Contact 435-619-3073. Motion to forgive \$350.00 off her water bill. 2nd by Pace. Unanimous vote.
