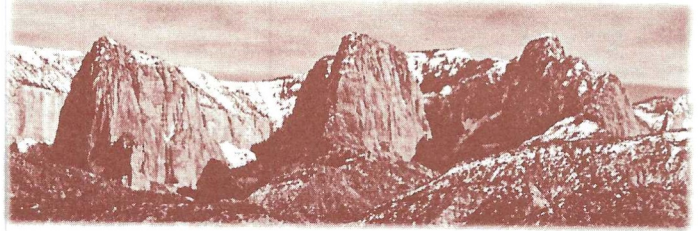

MINUTES

May 1, 2024

7:30 p.m.

Fire Station

Prayer – Councilmember Allen

Pledge – Councilmember Batty

Those in attendance: Councilmembers Allen, Batty, Pace.

Councilmember Larsen conducting in place of mayor, absent with illness.

1. Minutes from April 3, 2024 read by clerk. Motion to accept as read made by Allen, 2nd by Batty. Unanimous vote.
2. Bank Signatures – Clerk explained that a new signature card needed to be signed for those as signers on the checking account and including Councilmember Allen for his replacing Councilmember Ellis. Allen will need to go to State Bank main office with ID and sign. Signature card will then be given to clerk to signatures from other councilmembers.
3. Post Office improvements – Mayor was absent. Siding is being installed. Batty said the door was a 3-0 size door. Thinks it will be acceptable. Treasurer said that the main thing is to make sure the building is secure during remodel.
4. Reports – Fire Association Pancake breakfast. Booth available for reflective signs and chipping. 8am-11 a.m. Diane Stiller -reported on the Heritage Foundation grant. Schlosser still concerned about stray cats. Bothe Iron and Washington County animal shelters are full. Pace – sprinklers at park are done and running. Need a breaker installed at park and cemetery. Batty – dogs barking in his

area. Allen can't move on his lot without them going off. Coming from The old Kelsey home. Nuisance ordinance can be enforced with three letters of complaint. Batty will try to go and visit with the residents. Batty – reported that Alpha Engineering will be getting started when we get the application returned. Meter lids down by Frehner entrance need to be repaired. Allen – nothing Larsen – met with an asphalt guy to make improvements on road. Hasn't received the quote yet. Planning committee working on a survey for the residents about development, improvements, etc. Will have for next council meeting in June. Dorothy Reber family should be notified that there are trees encroaching into the stream bed on the north side of the bridge.
