13 Vice Chairman Kevin Pebley welcomed everyone and called to order the August

20 **A. Update on Reeder Excavation/Canyon Project**

21 The Board discussed the Reeder Excavation/Canyon Project, noting that
22 construction was progressing well with the diversion of stream flows and the site
23 being prepped for basin excavation. It was mentioned that concrete structures
24 are planned to be poured in the coming weeks. Photos of the project status were
25 viewed and an email update from Matt Robertson from Jones and Associates,
26 who was unable to attend, was read aloud.

28 **B. Update on Piping Overflow Ditch**

29 The overflow ditch topic was interlaced with the Reeder Excavation/Canyon
30 Project discussion. Authorization from property owner, Shirlene Peck, is pending
31 for piping through their property. While verbal approval was obtained, written
32 consent via agreements remained unsigned. The Board Members discussed
33 having Matt (Jones and Associates) or Bob (Perry City) get the signatures needed
34 from Shirlene. Chairman Bryce Thurgood stated that he would call Matt to follow
35 up.

37 **C. Regular Maintenance on Ditches**

The Board Members discussed the condition of different ditches including a suggestion to include the 3 Mile Creek basin in the maintenance package. The board contemplated waiting until spring for certain ditches. It was decided to have board member Taylor Clark assess the ditches and report back. A concern regarding tires in 3 Mile Creek was raised and included in the proposed assessment.

D. Update on Freeway Sinkhole

The Board Members discussed UDOT representatives having reportedly hired a contractor to repair the sinkhole near the freeway.

E. Update on CD Maturity

The CD maturity was updated from Vice Chairman Kevin Pebley with a report on a banking transaction in July where \$100,000.00 was moved into savings, leaving \$100,000.00 in the CD to mature on January 17th. Vice Chairman Pebley reported \$523,023.49 in savings, \$10,398.30 in checking and \$105,138.75 in the CD.

Board,

I won't be at the meeting today, but I spoke with Bryce and updated him on a few of the items. Here's a summary on the first few discussion items:

1. Mathias Debris Basin - Reeder Excavating is under construction, as you can probably all see. They have diverted the stream flows around the excavation area, have grubbed the site, and are working on the excavation of the basin. They plan to begin building the dike in the next couple of weeks and will be pouring the concrete structures the week of Sept 16th. I have attached a few pictures of the site.
2. I have received verbal approval from Shirlene Peck to pipe the Mathias Creek ditch through her property and I have sent her agreements to sign to give the Contractor permission to go on the property for the work. I have followed up with her a couple of times about the agreements, and while she said that there shouldn't be any problems, she hasn't signed them yet. Reeder would like to send a crew down there in the next couple of weeks to work on that piping.
3. If there are any ditches or basins that need cleaning; let us know and we can put together a bid package and request prices as we have done in the past.
4. I spoke with the UDOT Drainage Engineer regarding the sinkhole (pipe failure) on Threemile Creek on the west side of I-15. He said that they have a contractor on board to fix the problem, but he wasn't sure if they had started work on it yet.

Please let me know if there are any more questions or follow up needed on these items.

Hello Tyra and the Flood Control Board,

My name is Curtis Tonks, and I'm a risk finance consultant for the Utah Local Governments Trust. We are set up as a public agency insurance mutual under Utah's Governmental Immunity Act. The Trust is a non-profit local government that provides risk management and insurance services for nearly 600 agencies in the state of Utah. We work with many of your peers: Perry, Willard, Corinne, Box Elder Mosquito, Bear River Water and the Perry-Willard Wastewater Treatment Plant, among others.

For Box Elder County Perry City Flood Control and Drainage District, we provide the following insurance coverages:

1. **General Liability**: this covers your board and agency for any acts of negligence that cause bodily injury or property damage to third parties, and provides legal defense when you're sued but not negligible. It has a \$2M limit and \$0 deductible.
2. **Property**: this policy insures \$744,000 in district assets against perils like fire, wind and vandalism. It has a \$1,000 deductible.
3. **Position schedule bond**: this protects the District from financial crime and embezzlement by board members or employees.

I've attached a few items: a certificate of liability insurance, a listing of your insured properties and the Trust's 2023 annual report. There's some great claims stories in there! Please visit our website if you'd like more info: www.utahtrust.gov. I'm always happy to chat, too!
