### **Concession Stand updates**

The faucet and the drain at the concession stand needs to be fixed. Robert will have Petersons come down and work on fixing it.

### **Ballpark Nets**

The netting on the Baseball and Softball fields need to be replaced. Tyson says the previous nets cost about \$4,000. He says that the school board voted no on nets because they do not want the poles set up every 20 ft. at the park Robert comments that we have a lot of netting already purchased to cover the inside of the Park.

### **Fundraising (Jantz)**

Jantz has been working on getting quotes for banners to put at the Ball Fields. Jantz needs to get an exact price from the board to start selling them. Jantz believes we would raise more money selling banners at a lower price by selling more, than a higher price and selling fewer banners. The Board believes 4x8 banners would be the best size and the price of \$200 a year per banner seems to be a good price range or \$500 every 3 years. The banners will be put up in the spring, which will give individuals time to sell the banners ahead of time. I four media has great pricing, and the Board would like to go with them.

### **LDS Church (Mayor Leatherwood)**

The Mayor talked with Kade Penny about grants for lighting for the pickleball courts. Mayor Leatherwood would like to get Gary Keddington to start planning

ahead in order to get these types of things in our budget. The Mayor has been talking back and forth with a Lady from the LDS Church about the ball fields at the Centerfield City Church. The Mayor would like to get Pickleball courts put in at this location eventually.
