Brett Rawlins (Resident of Lehi) Expressed concerned about his ballot not being counted. Wants to do away with mail in voting.

Karen S. (Resident of Lakeshore) Expressed concern about mail in ballots, ballots not being counted and cost of the election.

Barbara Maxis (Resident of Orem) Expressed concern about mail ballots and keeping voter rolls updated.

Steve Watrus (Resident of Springville) Would like clarification on a graph that was shown, opposed to mail in ballots.

Jennifer Eves (Resident of Layton, State and Utah County delegate) Asked for the election results to not be certified today until all signatures on from Cox/Henderson petition are verified by Phil Lyman campaign.

Tiffany Barker (Precinct Chair from Lehi) Moms teach children patriotism by going to vote in person, wants right to public elections records.

Michelle Steel (Resident of Orem) Talked about Moms going to voting location and does not want mail in voting.

Kirsten Beebe (Resident of Orem) Concerns over voting registration and our current voting system Utah.

Jay Clerk (Resident of Lehi) Wants to keep elections secure, vote in person with ID, concerned about the Cox/Henderson petition and signature verifications.

Kimberly Fur (Precinct Chair from Orem) Does not want elections certified until Lyman campaign can verify the petition signatures and wants in person voting.

Kristen Richie (resident of Highland) Does not trust the elections or verification, wants transparency.

Heather Fry (Resident of Orem) Toured the elections office and expressed thanks to staff. Asked to wait on certification of elections until verification of signatures has been finished by Phil Lyman campaign.

Brett Rawlins (Resident of Lehi) asked that the elections not be certified until all questions have been satisfactorily resolved.

Steve Watrus (Resident of Springville) Stated that Phil Lyman wants to bring integrity and honesty to the election process.

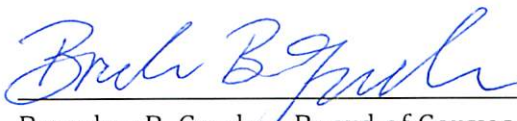
