Kevin Daniels postponed the closed session to the next meeting.

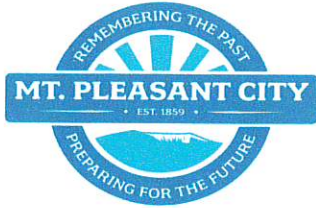
10. Council Reports:

Lynn Beesley

- Fall sports have been completed successfully.
- Winter sports are set to begin soon.
- Extended gratitude to Christa Lee for organizing the many activities for the Christmas Lighting event.

Paul Madsen

- Met with the individual managing the sprinkling system and park updates.
- Finalized the restroom location and is preparing bids for the old playground equipment, which will be sold and removed.
- Christa Lee requested the trailer for Christmas lighting and inquired about arranging a horse-drawn carriage for the city lighting. Plans to coordinate with Justin Brinkerhoff to organize a couple of teams for this.
- Christa Lee discussed the city's lighting plan, including a city light contest, a gingerbread contest, and an ongoing coat drive, which is progressing well.



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Russell Kiesel

- Two rows of blocks have been placed for the bathroom construction at the cemetery.
- Held a fundraiser at Horseshoe Mountain Hardware for the Veteran's Memorial project.

Rondy Black

- Attended the Master Plan meeting on October 10th; the next meeting with Sunrise is scheduled for this Thursday. Traffic data collection has been completed, and Mt. Pleasant will serve as a pilot location for video data collection to inventory roads.
- Planning and Zoning will host a public hearing next Tuesday to adopt the Subdivision Ordinance as mandated by the State of Utah.

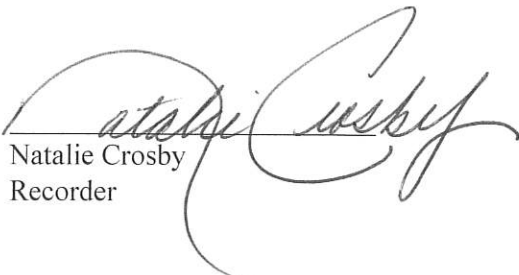
Cade Beck
