WHEREAS, he also served as 9<sup>th</sup> President of Weber State University from 1985 – 1990; and

WHEREAS, he has changed the future of Dixie State forever by gaining the institution university status in 2013; and

WHEREAS, he oversaw Dixie State's Centennial Celebration - Commemorating 100 Years of Service with several campus and community events over a 17-month span in advance of the institution's 100th birthday on September 19, 2011; and



WHEREAS, during his presidency, Dixie State University fully engaged with the community, including creating innovative partnerships with the City of St. George, the Washington County School District, Intermountain Healthcare and the Dixie Applied Technology College; and

WHEREAS, he holds a doctorate from UC-Berkeley, a Master of Business Administration from Harvard Business School, and a Bachelor's degree in Chemistry, with minors in Mathematics, Physics and French from BYU;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the members of the Utah State Board of Regents, joined by the Commissioner of Higher Education and his entire staff, and institution presidents, faculty, staff, and students of Utah express deep and sincere gratitude to Dr. Stephen D.
