EMS Response and Transport Fees

Grand County Emergency Medical Services SSD will charge at the allowable state mandated rates, these rates are set by the state and may change annually following the state fiscal year. Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated Title ~~5326-2d8a~~ 5403 and Administrative Rule ~~R911426~~ 8-200 the allowable ambulance rates beginning July 1, 20242 are as follows:

Base Rates:

Ground Ambulance	\$	1,000.00 <u>1,176.11</u>
Advanced EMT Ground Ambulance	\$	1,320.00 <u>1,552.68</u>
Paramedic Ground Ambulance	\$	1,930.00 <u>2,270.22</u>

Mileage Rates:

The standard mileage rate is \$~~42.2438-75~~ per mile or a fraction thereof. In all cases, mileage shall be computed from the point of pick-up to the point of patient delivery.

Fuel fluctuation rate changes may be granted when diesel fuel exceeds 5.10 per gallon or when gasoline exceeds 4.25 per gallon as invoiced; a surcharge of 0.25 per mile traveled may be assessed.

An off-road rate may be charged when an ambulance is required to travel for ten miles or more on unpaved roads. A surcharge of 1.50 per mile may be assessed.

Supplies and Medications:

A licensed ambulance provider may charge for supplies and for providing supplies, medications, and administering medications used on any response if (1) supplies and medication are priced fairly and competitively, (2) the individual does not refuse service, and (3) the licensed personnel for the licensed ambulance provider assess or treat the individual.

Hours are calculated from the time the unit leaves the station to the time the unit returns and is in service. Lunch breaks, or other pauses in service of less than four hours will be charged at the standard stand-by rate. Ambulances include 2 providers with at least one provider being ALS (advanced life support). If a patient requires transport from a stand-by event, they will be billed at the regular ambulance transport fee rate. Quick Response Vehicle will include 1 provider with BLS (basic life support) or ALS (advanced life support) based on need and availability. A supervisor will be required on any event with more than 3 EMS resources. A \$200.00 non-refundable deposit is required fourteen days prior to event coverage, anything scheduled within fourteen days of the date is an extra \$100 non-refundable deposit. Cancellation fees apply to any event canceled with less than 48 hours' notice. Overnight services will be subject to a surcharge. 501C-3's based out of Grand County Utah may be eligible for a 10% discount.
