1. Roll Call

2. Department Reports

Christa Lee Durrant

- Went over the schedule for the lighting on Saturday. Starting at 2:00 PM.
- 4 Hot Chocolate Stations, one will be in front of Liz Reams, one in front of the Mercantile, one in front of IHC, one in front of the Fire Station. Each Station will also have cookies.
- The bulk of the tables will be set up by the fire station.
- 4:00 Festivities begin. Would like Santa to enter in on the new fire truck.

- Russell also asked who ran the grater out to the Contoy. Asked Colter to fix a little bit by the Wasatch barn, a little bit of dirt has been left.



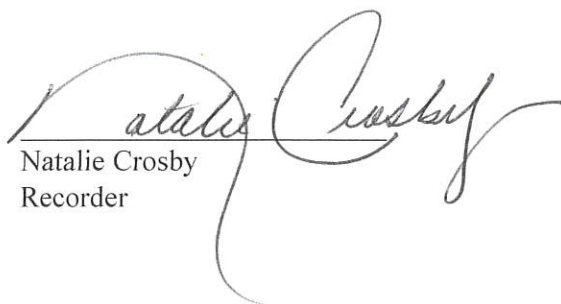
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- Lynn Beesley brought attention to the problem with the drainage down by the County Road by the Contoy. Colter will try to get a culvert underground to eliminate the problem.
