

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

NOVEMBER 19, 2024

A special meeting of the Juab County Commission was held November 19, 2024, 10:00 a.m. in the Juab County Commission Chambers, 160 North Main, Nephi, Utah.

Chairman Palmer welcomed all in attendance to the Canvass meeting for the 2024 General Election. Chairman Palmer excused Commissioner Kenison who could not be here. Treasurer Melanie Cowan was sitting in on the board of canvassers in his place as an alternate.

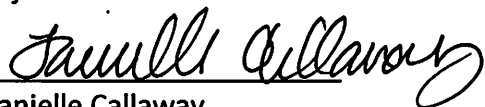
County Clerk/Auditor Tanielle Callaway presented the report for the 2024 General Election. She presented the statistics requested by the Lieutenant Governor's Office that details the number of ballots collected, rejected, cured and provisional ballots. Commissioner Painter inquired about the ballot that was not counted. Ms. Callaway indicated it was postmarked after Election Day and could not be counted. He also inquired as to what a provisional ballot was. Ms. Callaway stated those were mostly individuals who needed to update their voter registration or had recently moved to the county and had not registered to vote before the election.

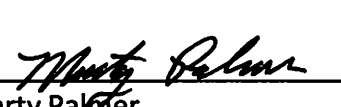
Ms. Callaway presented the summary of votes cast or the precinct summary report. She stated that in any precinct if there were fewer than 15 votes, those votes are hidden in order to protect the voter's right to a secret vote. Commissioner Painter inquired how the races ended up. Ms. Callaway pointed out the Tintic School Board race was a close race, being separated by one vote. She stated the losing candidate has seven days after the canvass to request a recount if they desire.

Ms. Callaway next presented the Election Affidavit, which states she complied with all state laws in performing the election. Next is the 2024 General Election summary report. The final document is the audit certification report detailing the results from the audit. No discrepancies were found. Commissioner Painter made a motion to certify the 2024 General Election as presented by the County Clerk. Chairman Palmer seconds the motion, no opposition, motion carries. All voted in favor.

Commissioner Painter made a motion to adjourn.
