

**NOTICE OF VACANCY ON THE BENJAMIN

All letters of interest in the vacant Board position must be received by the Board of County Commissioners, Utah County, Utah, on or before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2025. The Board of County Commissioners, Utah County, Utah, will review and evaluate all individuals that qualify for consideration pursuant to the guidelines listed above and will appoint an individual to fill the vacancy by resolution.
