

GOSHEN VALLEY LOCAL DISTRICT POLICY
ON
DRINKING WATER SAMPLING AND TESTING

In 2024, Goshen Valley Local District (GVLD) received a request for PFAS testing of the water supply. The Utah State Division of Drinking Water has primacy for implementing and enforcing the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, including the recent National Primary Drinking Water Regulation for six PFAS made effective on June 25, 2024 (the “PFAS Regulations”). Although GVLD is not required to follow the PFAS Regulations because GVLD does not operate a non-transient non-community public water system, the District will proactively monitor for the contaminants included in the PFAS Regulations as follows:

1. GVLD will coordinate and work directly with the Elberta Water Company (EWC), or EWC’s contractor, to sample the water directly from EVA#1 well on an annual basis.
2. EWC will deliver the water samples to a properly certified laboratory to be tested for the contaminants covered by the PFAS Regulations and will provide a copy of the testing results to GVLD.
3. EWC will also provide a copy of the testing results to the Utah State Division of Drinking Water as required by law.
4. If contaminants covered by the PFAS Regulations are found in the water sample, EWC will notify GVLD immediately and action will be taken by the Board as necessary.
