a. Park & Recreation Impact Fees

Ben Correy with Sunrise presented what Sunrise Engineering's price would be to do a study for Park and Recreation Impact Fees. There was some discussion on if impact fees would help the Recreation Department. The base study would be \$49,000.00 but Ben stated it could be more tailored to the city's needs. Mayor Olsen suggested possibly discussing this in the next work session.

Ben also gave a quick report on the treatment plant.

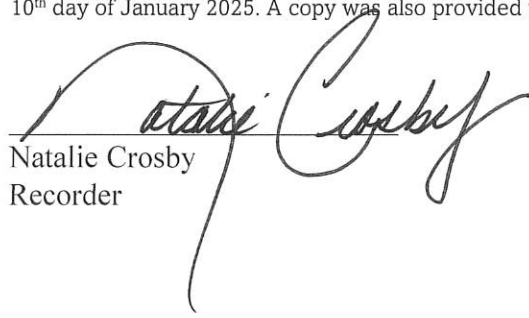
