(2) Case No. 11-1047

(4) Case No. 13-1178

The Commission recommends suspension of the educator’s Level 2 Secondary and Career and Technical Education License in UPPAC case no. 13-1178. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following

satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than one (1) year from the date of Board action. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.

(5) Case No. 14-1183

The Commission recommends suspension of the educator's Level 2 Elementary and Administrative/Supervisory Education License in UPPAC case no. 14-1183. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than six (6) months from the date of Board action. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.

(6) Case No. 13-1165

The Commission recommends suspension of the educator's Level 2 Secondary Education License in UPPAC case no. 13-1165. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than the termination of his plea in abeyance by the court. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.
